### Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Using a ruler, fold the tabs inward on the tower. (P2a, P2b)

### Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

### Adding the International Children

- Adhere a foam dimensional to the back of the international children. (P3)
- Place the children on each tower level as desired. (P4a, P4b)

### Main Page

- Run a line of double-sided tape onto the indicators on the Main Page. (P5)
- Place the folded tabs on the double-sided tape to secure to page. (P6a, P6b)

### Hebrew Words

- On one cloud, write the following: (P7)
  - > 1) Saphah 2) שפה (3) Language
- On the other cloud, write the following: (P8)
  - > 1) Migdal2) מגדל (2) 3) Tower
- Adhere a foam dimensional to the back of each cloud and place the cloud on the Main Page on both sides of the tower. (P9)

You now have a visual representation of the Tower of Babel as well as some children representing some of the languages that began as a result of that incident.




