Precious Possessions

NOTEBOOK PAGE

Materials:

- Cardstock white
- Cardboard
- Toothpick (for staff)
- Puffy paint blue (for water)
- Sequins gold & silver (for sacks)
- Puncturing tool
- Brads
- · Glue or Tacky glue
- Scissors
- Optional: gold & silver pens, puffy paint or markers
- · Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to cut out the Template pieces for them.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)

Main Page

- Add blue puffy paint to well to represent the water and allow to dry. (P2)
- Glue gold sequins onto one sack and silver sequins onto the other sack. (P3)
- Glue sack onto Main Page under the well. (P3)
- Optional: if you do not have sequins use gold and silver pens, markers or puffy paint.
- Break a tooth pick so that you have a shorter piece to go above the servant's hand and a longer piece to go below the servant's hand on his staff. (P4)



Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

- Place a strip of glue on the staff of the servant. Place toothpick pieces above the servant's hand and below it. Allow to dry. (P5)
- Take the stone template and trace it onto the cardboard. Repeat as many times as you like. Cut out the pieces. (P6)
- Glue the pieces onto the well. (P7)

Joining the Character Pieces

- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole in each of the indicated areas.
 (P8)
- Connect the pieces together with a brad, but do NOT open the back of the brad yet. Connect the following: (P9)
 - > the camel head and body (B1)
 - > the waist and skirt of Ribgah (B2)
- Puncture holes on the Main Page at B1 and B2. (P10)
- Connect the following to the Main Page:
 - > camel to B1
 - > Ribgah to B2

- > 1) Eved




