
NOTEBOOK PAGE

The Servant Finds Yitshaq a Wife

Genesis 24:1-27

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Toothpick (for staff)
- Puffy paint - blue (for water)
- Sequins - gold & silver (for sacks)
- Puncturing tool
- Brads - small
- Glue Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)



Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to cut out the Template pieces for them.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the following indicated areas:
 - (B1) camel on Main Page (P2a)
 - (B2) Ribqah on Main Page (P2b)
 - (B1) camel piece (P2c)
 - (B2) Ribqah piece (P2d)
- Insert a small brad through the following:
 - (B1) camel piece and camel on Main Page (P3a)
 - (B2) Ribqah piece and Ribqah on Main Page (P3b)



Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:


- Apply glue to the coin area on the Main Page. (P4)
- Place silver and gold sequins on the glue. (P5a, P5b)
- Break a toothpick so that you have a shorter piece to go above the servant's hand and a longer piece to go below the servant's hand on his staff. (P6)
- Apply a strip of glue on the staff of the servant. (P7)
- Place toothpick pieces above the servant's hand and below it. (P8a, P8b)
- Allow to dry.
- Using blue puffy paint, add dimension to the water in the well. (P9)
- Allow to dry.
