

Precious Possessions

NOTEBOOK PAGE

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Tissue paper - yellow
- Felt - cream or brown
- Yarn or string - 12" piece (2)
- Small buttons (10)
- Aluminum foil
- X-acto knife
- Double-sided tape
- Glue or Tacky glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Template: Main Page (BW or color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Main Page on white cardstock.
- Cut 5" x 5" piece of felt.
- Cut 2 pieces of yarn each 12" in length.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Using an X-acto knife, make a cut on the 'x'. (P1)
- Run a line of double-sided tape from the 'x' down to the base on each side and along the bottom. (P2)
- Place the 5" x 5" felt onto the tape strip at the bottom as pictured, then press down firmly. (P3)
- Fold the left and right edge of the felt so that they fit inside the square on the Main Page. (P4)

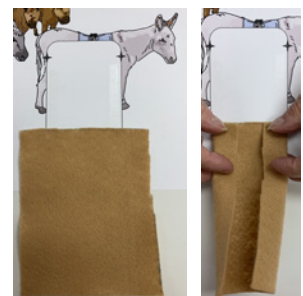

Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

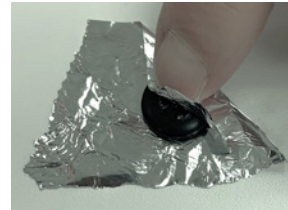
- Press the folded edges onto the adhesive strips creating a sack. (P5a, P5b)
- Wrap the 10 small buttons with aluminum foil to create silver coins. (P6a, P6b)
- Push the 2 pieces of yarn through the back of the Main Page so that both ends come out on each side of the sack. (P7a, P7b)
- Crinkle up a piece of yellow tissue paper and stuff the sack. (P8)
- Add glue to the back of each coin and place on tissue. (P9a, P9b)
- Tie the 2 strings around the bag. (P10)

 - 1) Shever 2) שבר 3) Grain/Corn (P13)

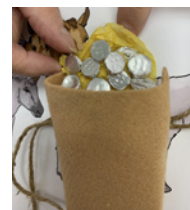
You now have a visual representation of the grain as well as silver placed back in the brothers' sacks of their donkeys.

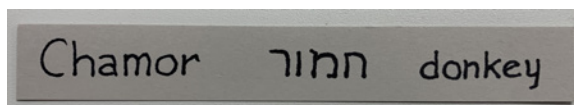

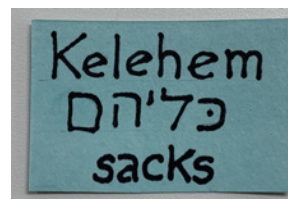

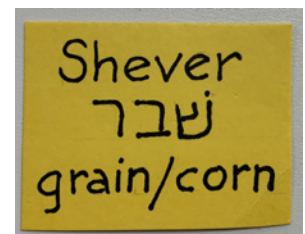
