

Precious Possessions

CRAFT

Ya'aqob and Family

Genesis 29:32-35; 30:4-8, 9-13, 17-21, 24

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Craft sticks - jumbo (9)
- Masking tape (to connect craft sticks)
- Ruler (to assist in folding tabs)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Craft Templates: A (BW) or B (color)



Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Templates of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Craft:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Note that the background colors of the children match their mothers: (P1)
 - Le'ah and children - yellow
 - Rahel and children - light blue
 - Zilpah and children - lilac
 - Bilhah and children - pink
- Using a ruler and pencil, make a mark in the middle of each craft stick. (P2)
- Using scissors, cut the 9 craft sticks in half. (P3)
- Run a glue stick onto each craft stick and place each character over the glue. (P4a, P4b)

Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Flip the craft stick over and run a glue stick on the back of each tab—then fold the tab onto the back of the craft stick. (P5a, P5b)
 - Facing forward, group the children with their moms and place Ya'aqob in between Le'ah and Rahel. Place the concubines with their children on the same side as their owner; Zilpah on the same side as Le'ah and Bilhah on the same side as Rahel. (P6)
 - Flip the craft sticks onto the back showing the names. (P7)
 - Starting with Le'ah, Ya'aqob and Rahel, place masking tape on the craft sticks to connect them. (P8)
 - Connect Le'ah's children next to her. (P9)
 - Connect Zilpah and her children on the same side as Le'ah and her children. (P10)
 - Moving to the other side, connect Rahel's children next to her. (P11)
 - Lastly, connect Bilhah and her children on the same side as Rahel and her children. (P12)
 - Your 18 characters are now connected to each other. (P13a, P13b)
- * *Although Binyamin is not yet born in this parsha, we have included him to complete the family.*

You now have a visual representation of Ya'aqob's family.

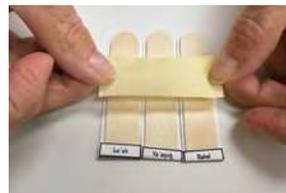

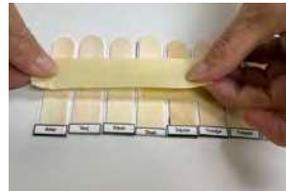

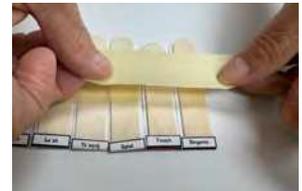
