
CRAFT

Sukkah

Genesis 33:17

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Dremel - (with cutting wheel attachment)
- Cardboard - wood color
- Craft sticks - regular (10)
- Chopsticks (5)
- Coffee stirrers - wood (4)
- Paper cutter or scissors
- Ruler
- Hot glue or wood glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Craft Templates: A (BW) or B (color)



Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Template of choice on white cardstock.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to cut out the cardboard and wooden pieces for them.
- Using a paper cutter or scissors, cut the cardboard pieces the following lengths:
 - floor - $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$
 - left side - $2'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$
 - roof - $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8''$
 - front right - $2'' \times 2''$
- Using your Dremel or cutting device of choice, cut the wood coffee stirrers and chopsticks the following lengths:
 - coffee stirrers - $5\frac{1}{2}''$ (4 for the left side)
 - chopsticks - $5''$ (3 for the front)
 - chopsticks - $3\frac{1}{2}''$ (2 for the back)

Instructions for the Craft:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- If not done already, cut out all cardboard and wood pieces as instructed in the P/T Preparation section.
- Lay out your cardboard and wood pieces. (P2a, P2b)
- Lay out the $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$ floor cardboard piece and the (3) $5''$ chopsticks to start assembling the front side of the sukkah. (P3)
- Hot glue 2 of the $5''$ chopsticks onto the floor cardboard piece on the shorter $4\frac{1}{2}''$ side at both ends. Hot glue the third chopstick to the cardboard $2''$ from the right chopstick. (P4)



Instructions for the Craft cont'd:


- Lay out the (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " chopsticks on the opposite side of the cardboard floor. (P5)
- Hot glue the (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " chopsticks to the cardboard at the ends on the back side of the sukkah. (P6)
- Take your 2" x 2" front right cardboard piece and add a strip of hot glue to 2 opposite ends. (P7)
- Place the cardboard piece on the chopsticks that are 2" apart on the right front side of the sukkah. (P8)
- Take your 2" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " left side cardboard piece and add a strip of hot glue to the 2 short ends. (P9)
- Place the cardboard piece on the chopsticks that are on the right side of the sukkah near the short cardboard piece in the front of the sukkah. (P10)
- Lay your sukkah on its right side to complete the left side. Apply a drop of hot glue to the chopsticks evenly, placing one coffee stirrer at a time on the glue until all 4 are placed. Make sure to leave some space between the sticks. (P11a, P11b, P11c, P11d, P11e)
- Lay your sukkah on its front side to complete the back side. Apply a drop of hot glue to the chopsticks evenly, placing one craft stick at a time on the glue until all 10 are placed. Make sure to leave no space between the sticks. (P12a, P12b, P12c, P12d)







Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Stand your sukkah up on its base (floor) and apply hot glue to the tips of the 5 chopsticks. Take your $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" roof and lay it on top of the chopsticks. It will lay on an angle. (P13a, P13b)
- Your sukkah is now complete.
 - front (P14a)
 - back (P14b)
 - left side (P14c)
 - right side (P14d)
- Using a ruler to assist you, fold the tabs on the animals inward. (P15a, P15b)
- Place the animals inside the sukkah. (P16)

You now have a visual representation of the sukkah that Ya'aqob built to house his animals.
