### **Materials:**

- · Cardstock white & green
- Paper bowl dessert size
- · Pebbles small
- Scissors
- Tacky glue
- Hot glue
- Craft Templates: A & B (BW) or C & D (color)

# Burial Site of Patriarchs and Matriarchs

Genesis 50:13



#### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- · Print Craft Templates of choice on white cardstock.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to cut out the Template pieces for them.

# Instructions for the Craft:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)

## Creating the Cave

- Cut a small paper dessert plate in half. (P2a)
- Cut around the bottom of the plate where the round edges are. (P2b, P2c)

## Instructions for the Craft Cont'd:

#### Decorating the Cave

- Using a gray coloring medium of choice, color the outside of the plate. (P3a, P3b)
- Using Tacky glue, run along the rim of the plate and place the back of the cave against the glue. Make sure that you see the brown back of the cave before adhering. (P4a, P4b)
- Using hot glue, add some drops on the curve of the cave and place some small pebbles on the glue. (P5a, P5b)


#### Creating the Tree

- Using scissors cut the dotted lines on both tree pieces. (P6a, P6b)
- Insert one tree piece into the other. (P7a, P7b)

#### Finishing the Craft

- Fold the patriarchs and matriarchs images along the lines. (P8)
- Place the cave, tree, patriarchs and matriarchs where desired on a sheet of green cardstock.

You now have a visual representation of the patriarchs and matriarchs that were buried in the cave of the field of Makpelah.
