
NOTEBOOK PAGE

The Burning Bush

Exodus 3:1-6, 13-15

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Craft tissue paper - red, orange, yellow, green
- Velcro dots - hook & loop
- Brads
- Repositionable glue
- Puncturing tool
- Double-sided adhesive foam dimensional
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)



Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)

Assembling Mosheh

- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the 'x' on standing Mosheh. (P2)
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the 'x' on Mosheh's arms. (P3a, P3b)
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the 'x' on kneeling Mosheh pieces. (P4a, P4b)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Using a brad, connect Mosheh's arm on standing Mosheh. (P5a)
- Using a brad, connect kneeling Mosheh's body pieces. (P5b)
- Standing Mosheh's arms should be able to move up and down as well as kneeling Mosheh should be able to bend at the waist. (P6)

Embellishing the Bush

- Apply glue to the trunk and branches of the bush. (P7)
- Scrunch up some red, orange, yellow and green craft tissue and place on the glue to create leaves and flames. (P8a, P8b)
- Adhere a double-sided adhesive foam dimensional to the back of the bush. (P9)
- Place the bush onto the Main Page in the rocky area. (P10)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

Main Page

- Attach a *Velcro* dot 'loop side' on the Main Page where you will put standing Mosheh and kneeling Mosheh. (P11)
- Attach a *Velcro* dot 'hook side' to the back of standing and kneeling Mosheh toward the bottom of the characters. (P12)

Enacting the Story

- Place standing Mosheh on the Main Page to show him arriving at the burning bush. (P13)
- You can switch out standing Mosheh for kneeling Mosheh. (P14)
- Run repositionable glue on the back of the snake. (P15)
- Place the snake further away from Mosheh to show the rod that became a snake. (P16a)
- Place the snake in kneeling Mosheh's hand to show him picking up the snake that will become a rod. (P16b)

Hebrew Words

- Write the following directly on the Main Page or on a piece of colored cardstock and glue to the page:
 - 1) Ehyeh asher Ehyeh
 - 2) אהיה אשר אהיה
 - 3) I Am that (which) I Am (P17)
- 1) Aish
- 2) אש
- 3) Fire (P18)


