

# Precious Possessions

## NOTEBOOK PAGE

### Materials:

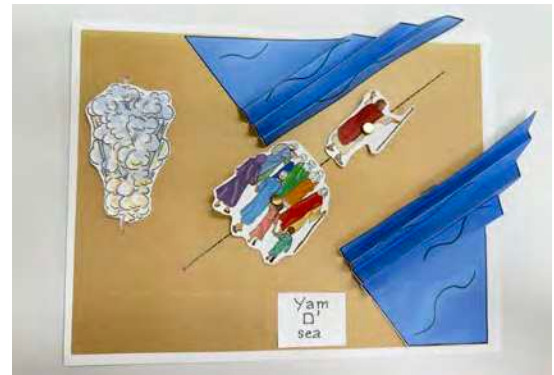
- Cardstock - tan & white
- Copy paper
- Yarn
- Threading needle (to pull yarn through the holes)
- Puncturing tool
- Brads
- Velcro dots - small, round
- X-acto knife
- Clear tape
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Craft Templates: Main Page, A, water (BW) or Main Page, B, water (color)

#### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Main Page of choice & Notebook Template A or B on white cardstock.
- Print the water of choice on copy paper.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to assist in cutting out the slit on the Main Page.

### Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)

#### Preparing the Main Page

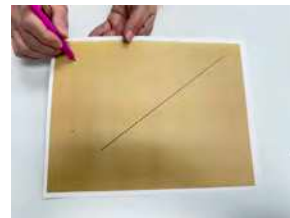
- Using an X-acto knife, cut out the diagonal line on the Main Page. (P2)
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the 2 dots on the Main Page. (P3)
- Place the 2 water pieces on the Main Page so that they are on the correct side and facing the correct way. (P4)



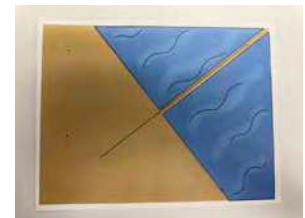

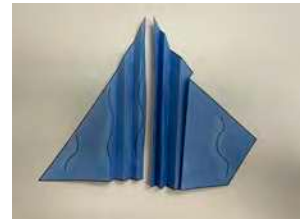

## Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

### *Assembling the Water Walls*

- Accordion fold each water piece about 1 inch wide with 3-4 folds, leaving enough room to adhere the edge of the water to the Main Page. (P5)
- Run a glue stick on the back of the water pieces on the flat edge and adhere to the Main Page on the correct side of the slit. (P6a, P6b, P6c, P6d)
- Adhere small round 'hook & loop' *Velcro* dots to the first fold on the back side of the waves. (P7a, P7b)
- Pull both waves to the slit and connect the *Velcro* dots to the Main Page. (P8a, P8b)



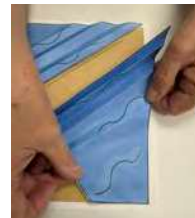

## Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

### *Attaching the Pillar of Cloud and Fire*

- Cut a piece of yarn twice the length of the top and bottom dots on the Main Page. (P9)
- Run a glue stick on the back of the pillar of cloud. (P10)
- Lay the cut yarn down the center of the glue. (P11)
- Place the pillar of fire over the yarn and glue. (P12)
- The yarn will be above and below the pillars. (P13a, P13b)
- Using a threading needle, insert the top end of the yarn through it. (P14)
- Insert the needle with yarn through the top hold on the Main Page. (P15)
- Repeat for the bottom end. (P16)
- Flip the Main Page over and using clear tape, connect the 2 ends of the yarn. (P17)
- You can flip the pillar of cloud over to reveal the pillar of fire and vice versa. (P18a, P18b)

# Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

## Assembling and Adding the Characters

- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the dots on the characters. (P19a, P19b)
- Insert the brads through the holes on the characters. (P20)
- Insert the characters through the slit on the Main Page. (P21a, P21b)
- You now can slide the characters through the parted water, close or separate the water and flip the pillar of cloud or fire to interact with the scene. (P22a, P22b)

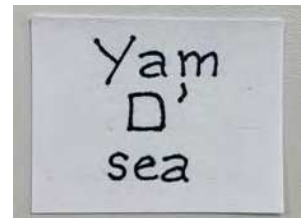
