
## **NOTEBOOK PAGE**


### Materials:

- · Cardstock white
- Plastic wrap
- Clear tape
- Glitter glue gold
- Brad long
- Dimensional foam
- · Puncturing tool
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)

### **Anointing Aharon**

Exodus 29:7





#### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.

## Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out crystal flask with anointing oil and hand. (P1)

### Using the Gold Glitter Glue

- Apply gold glitter glue to:
  - > Aharon's gold plate (P2a)
  - Gold edging, rings and cords on the breastplate (P2b)
  - 3 pieces of plastic wrap rolled tight (P2c)

## Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

#### Crystal Flask

- Glue a dimensional to the back of the crystal flask making sure to leave an opening in the middle of the foam dimensional to add the long brad. (P3)
- Using a puncturing tool, make a hole through the crystal flask where the opening is around the foam dimensional. (P4)
- Glue the crystal flask to the Main Page on the right side making sure that when it is upright or when it pours it doesn't come off the page.
- Using a puncturing tool, make a hole through the already existing hole on the crystal flask and the Main Page. (P5)
- Insert the long brad through the flask and the Main Page. (P6)
- You should be able to have the flask stand upright or tilt for pouring. (P7a, P7b)

### Attaching the Oil

 Using clear tape, attach the 3 strands of gold plastic wrap to the back of the pour spout on the crystal flask. (P8a, P8b)




- Write the following directly on the Main Page or a piece of colored cardstock:
