Precious Possessions

NOTEBOOK PAGE

Materials:

- Cardstock white
- Double-sided foam dimensional
- Brads
- Toothpick color of choice
- Jewels, gems or sequins of choice
- Puncturing tool
- Scissors
- Glue & hot glue
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

• Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:


- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- If using colored Templates, color banner as desired. (P1)
- Embellish Queen Ester and King Ahashwerosh with jewels, gems or sequins as desired. (P2)

Attaching King Ahashwerosh and Queen Ester to Main Page

- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through each 'x" on the king and Ester.
- Position the king on the Main Page near the throne so that his feet touch the edge of the stage. (P3)
- Position Ester to the left and below the stage so that the king's scepter can touch her head when she bends. (P3)
- Insert a brad through the shoulder and torso of the king. (P4)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Using a pencil, mark where the shoulder brad lines up with the Main Page. (P4)
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the Main Page.
- Push the brad on the king's shoulder through the cardstock to attach the king to the Main Page. (P5)
- Attach the forearm piece to the shoulder piece at the elbow with a brad. (P6)
- Using glue of choice, add glue to both legs of the king to attach him to the Main Page. (P7)
- The king is now completed. His arm and shoulder should be able to move up and down. (P8)
- Insert a brad through the 2 holes to connect Ester's body. (P9)
- Using a pencil, mark where the brad lines up with the Main Page.
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the Main Page.
- Push the brad through the cardstock to attach Ester to the Main Page. (P10)

Creating the King's Scepter

- Using a colored toothpick, hot glue 2 half round gems to either side. (P11)
- Hot glue the 'scepter' to the back of the king's hand. (P12)



Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

Hebrew Words

• Write the following Hebrew words on each side of the banner: (P13)

| 1) Melek | <mark>מלך</mark> (2 | 3) King |
|-------------|-----------------------|-----------------|
| > 1) Malkah | <mark>מלכּה</mark> (2 | 3) Queen |

Attaching the Banner

- You can use double-sided foam dimensionals to adhere to the back of the banner and the Main Page. We used regular glue to add our dimensionals to the back of the banner. (P14)
- If you used glue, add to the back of the dimensional and place banner on the right side of the Main Page so that the wood tip touches the stage. (P15)

You now have a visual representation of Ester standing before the king and then bowing as he extends his scepter to her. (P16, P17)


