Special Instructions:

We have created two different options for this craft. The first is for a standard Notebook Page. The second is a 3-D version of the two Furniture Pieces for the Courtyard. Parsha Terumah 19.1 KB lesson also had a craft option for the four 3-D Furniture Pieces for the Mishkan. We recommend that you store all the 3-D furnishings in a shoebox or plastic bin.

Materials:

- Cardstock white
- Foam dimensional
- Puffy paint copper shades (for furnishings) & blue (for water)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Optional: toothpick (to assist in placing puffy paint)
- Notebook Templates: A (BW) or B (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

• Print Notebook Template of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Standard Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Embellish the bronze basin and altar with copper and bronze puffy paint. You can add some to the grating and the poles on the altar as well. (P2a, P2b)
- Set pieces aside to dry.
- Once pieces are dry, add foam dimensionals to the back of each piece. (P3)
- Glue each furniture piece to a sheet of cardstock. (P4)


