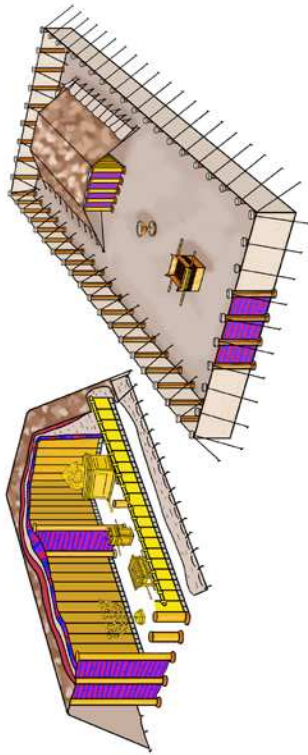
Shemot 35:1-3



Work is done for six days, but on the seventh day it shall be set-apart to you, a Sabbath of rest to Yahweh. Anyone doing work on it is put to death.

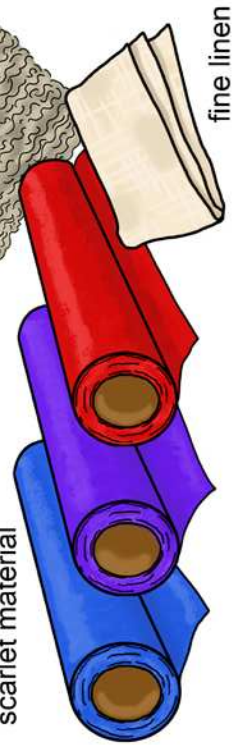

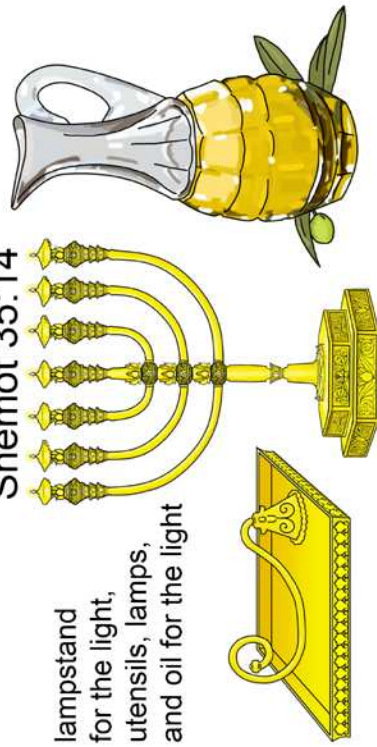
the ark and its poles, the lid of atonement and the veil of the covering

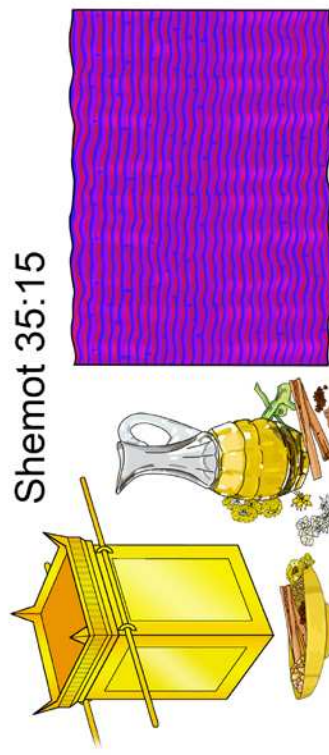
the table, poles, utensils, and the showbread

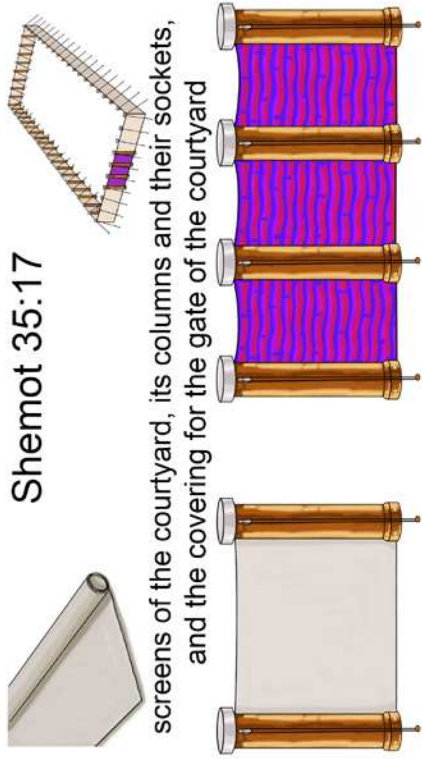
lampstand for the light, utensils, lamps, and oil for the light

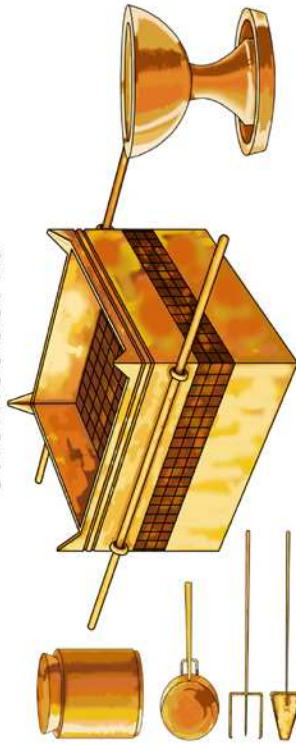
screens of the courtyard, its columns and their sockets, and the covering for the gate of the courtyard

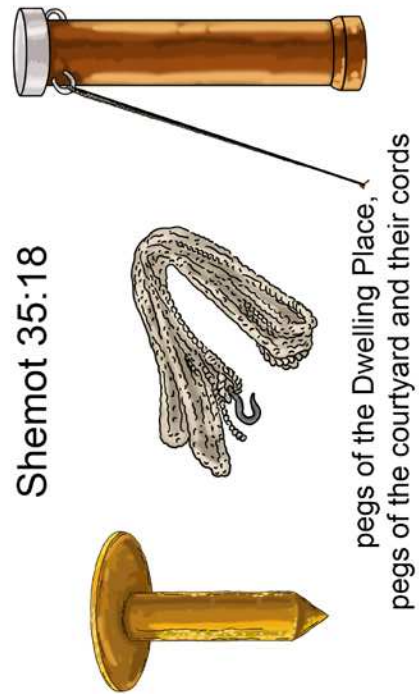
the set-apart garments for Aharon the priest and his sons to serve as priests

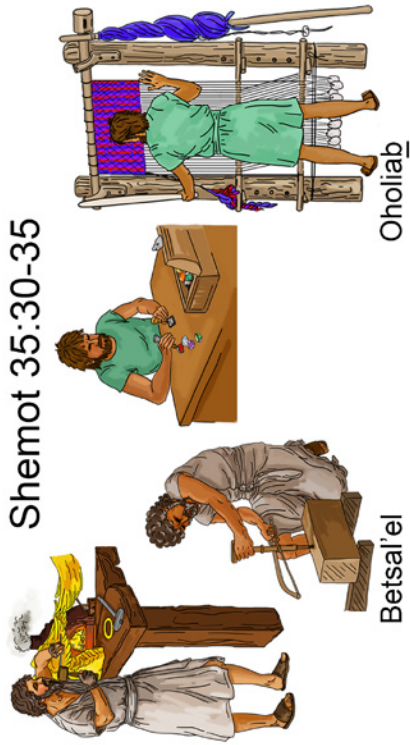
pegs of the Dwelling Place, pegs of the courtyard and their cords

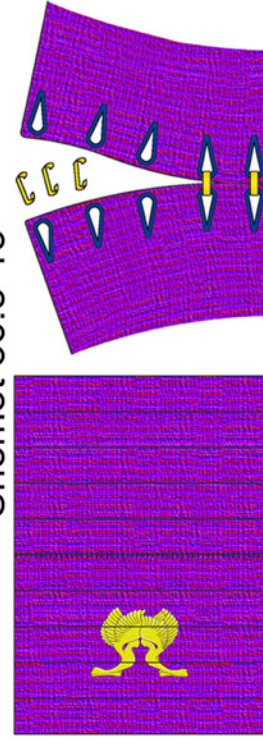

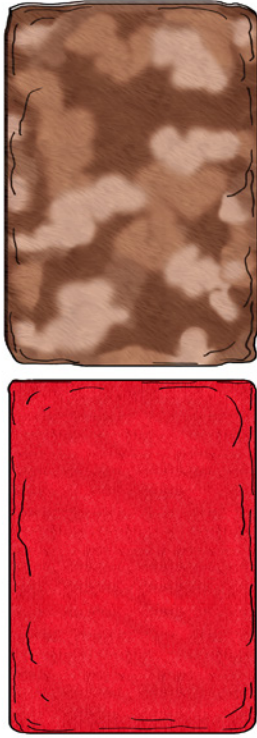
The people bring much more than enough for the service of the work which Yahweh commanded us to do.

50 blue loops joined by 50 gold hooks

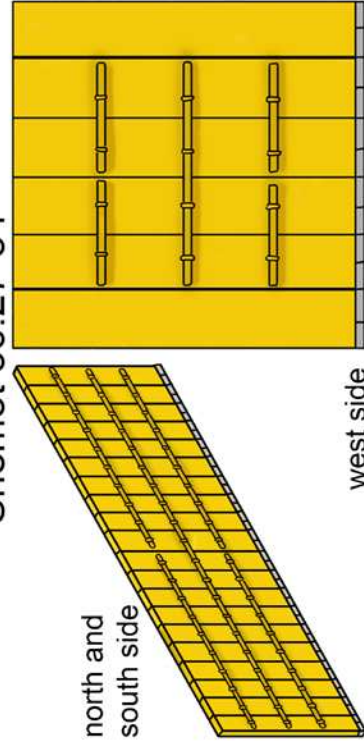

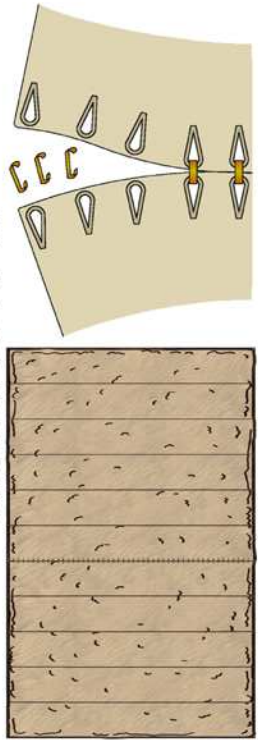

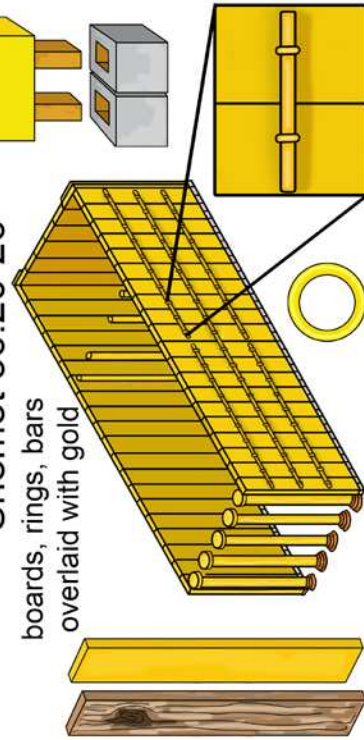

50 loops joined by 50 bronze hooks

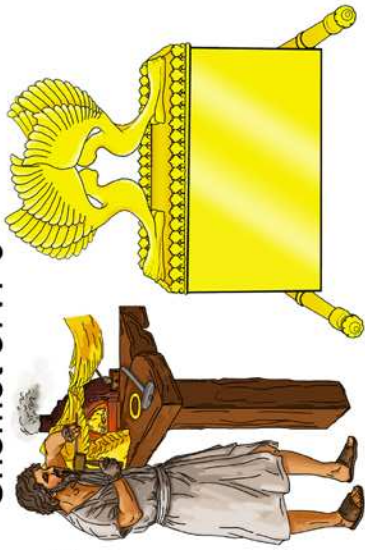

overlaid with gold

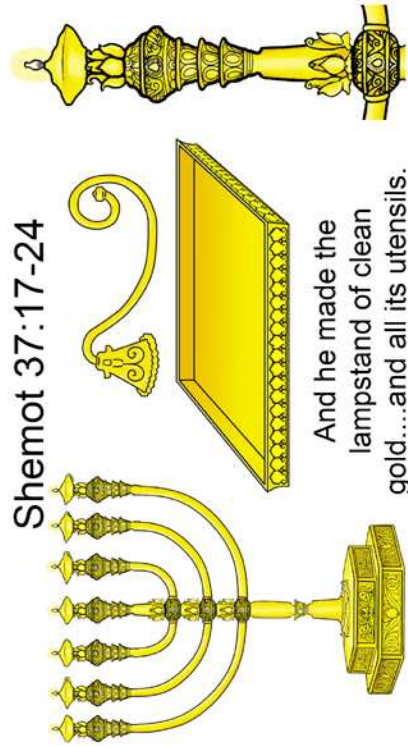
Shemot 37:1-9

Betsal'el made the ark out of acacia wood overlaid it in gold with kerubim on the lid.



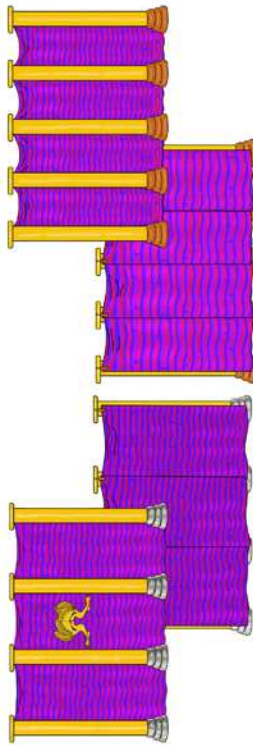
Shemot 37:17-24

And he made the lampstand of clean gold....and all its utensils.



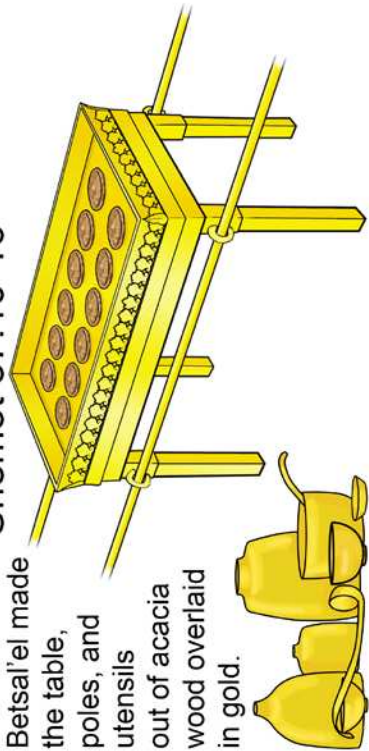
Shemot 36:35-38

blue, scarlet, and purple veils, gold columns inner veil: kerubim, 4 columns, silver sockets outer veil: 5 gold columns, bronze sockets



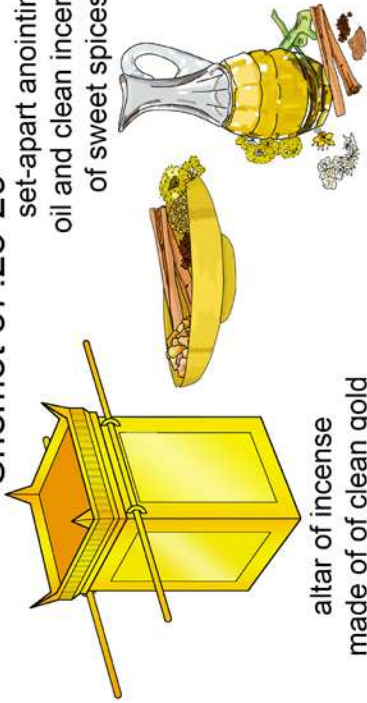

Betsal'el made the table, poles, and utensils out of acacia wood overlaid in gold.



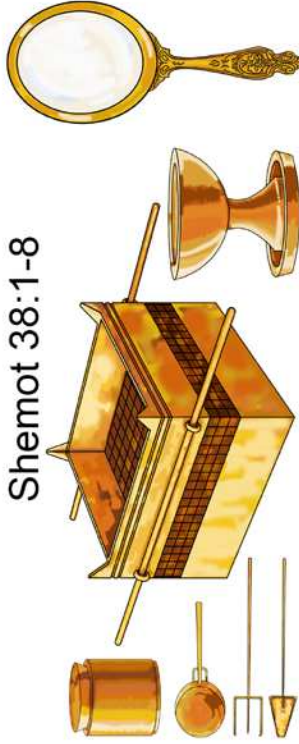

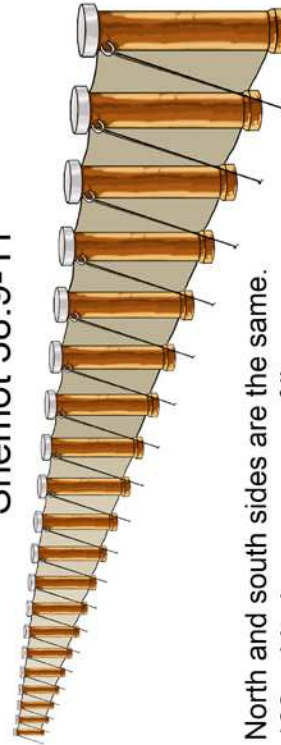
Shemot 38:1-8



The bronze altar, utensils, basin of bronze, and its stand were made from bronze mirrors of the serving women who did service at the door of the Tent of Meeting.

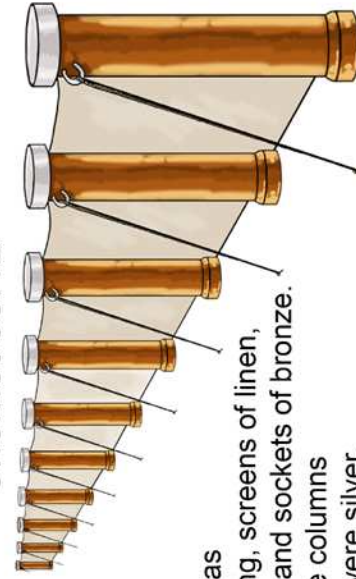
Shemot 38:9-11

Hooks of the columns and bands were silver.

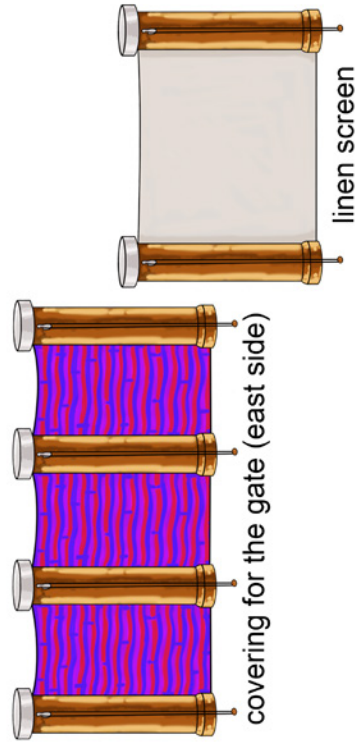

and bands were silver.



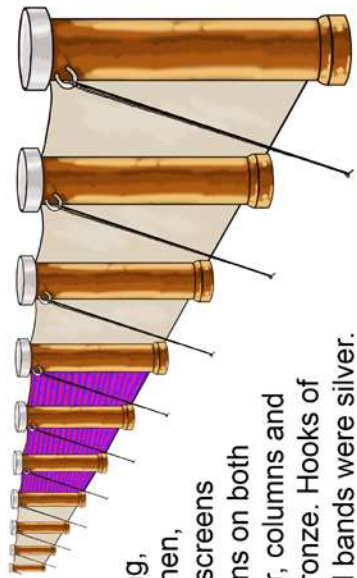
