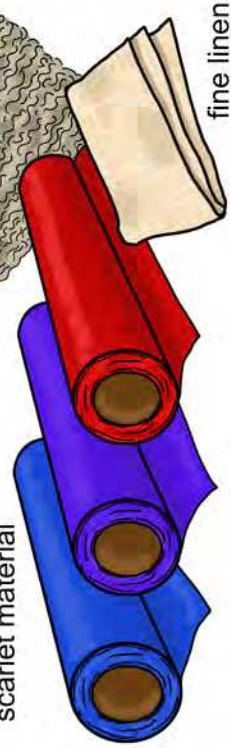
Shemot 35:1-3



Work is done for six days, but on the seventh day it shall be set-apart to you, a Sabbath of rest to Yahweh. Anyone doing work on it is put to death.

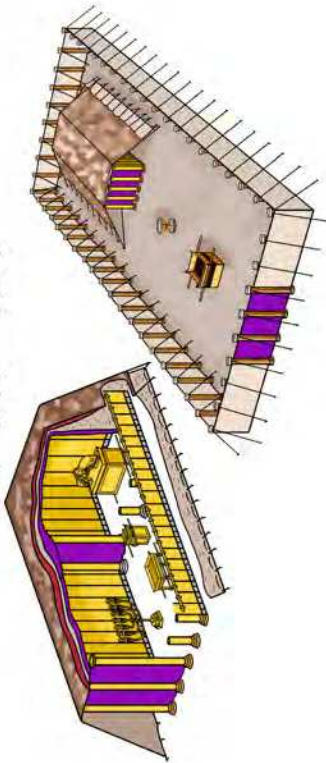

And he made the basin of bronze and its stand of bronze, from the bronze mirrors of the serving women who did service at the door of the Tent of Meeting.

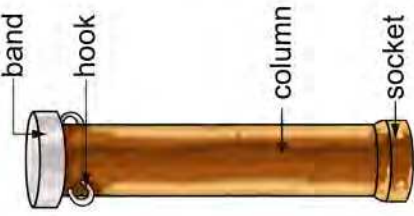




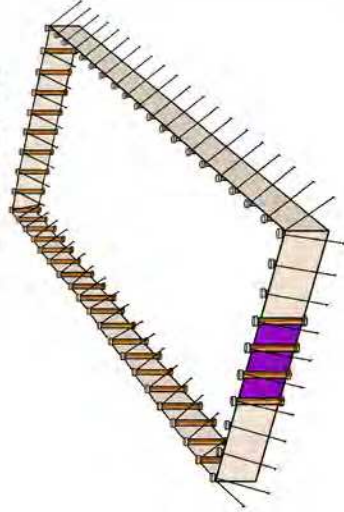

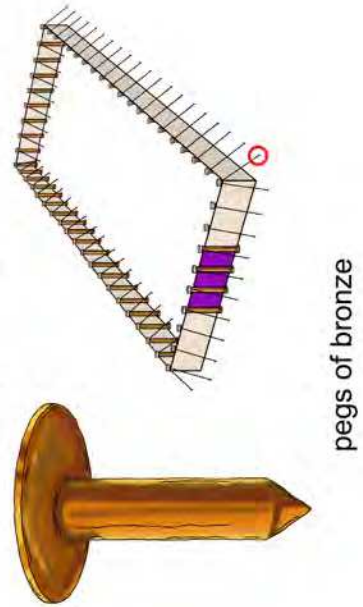
