# Precious Possessions

### **CRAFT**

### Materials:

- · Cardboard
- Ribbon 5/8" any light color except red or green; 1/8" red & green
- Ruler
- Safety pin
- Double-sided adhesive tape
- Clear tape
- Scissors

#### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Cut a piece of cardboard 4" X 4".
- Cut 12 pieces of 5/8" color of choice ribbon 6" long.
- Cut 1-2 pieces of 1/8" red ribbon 6" long.
- Cut 1-2 pieces of 1/8 " green ribbon 6" long.

### Instructions for the Craft:

- Stage the 6 pieces of ribbon horizontally on the square cardboard. (P1)
- Lay the remaining 6 pieces of ribbon vertically over the horizontal pieces on the square cardboard. (P2)
- Make sure that there are minimal gaps between the pieces.

### Laying the Ribbon Horizontally

- Place double-sided adhesive tape along each edge of the cardboard square. (P3a)
- Remove paper backing from each adhesive piece. (P3b)
- Starting at the bottom, lay the 6 ribbons strip ends over the adhesive. (P4a, P4b)



### Instructions for the Craft Cont'd:


- Bring each ribbon strip over to the front side of the cardboard and lay the ends onto the adhesive tape on the back side. (P5a, P5b, P5c)
- Cut off any excess ribbon. (P6)
- Flip the cardboard over to make sure the front is nice and taut. (P7)

### Laying the Ribbon Vertically

- Cut 2 pieces of double-sided adhesive tape to lay over the ribbon. Remove paper backing from adhesive. (P8a, P8b)
- Lay the end of one ribbon strip over the tape on the back side. Repeat for the remaining ribbon pieces. (P9a, P9b)
- Flip the cardboard to the front and lay out the ribbon. (P10)

### Instructions for the Craft Cont'd:

- Starting with the bottom piece, start weaving in between the horizontal ribbon. Alternate each row with over-under and underover weaving. (P11a, P11b, P11c)
- Cut any excess ribbon. (P12)
- Flip cardboard over to the front. (P13)

#### Adding the Tzara'at

- Using a safety pin attached to one of the thin ribbons, start weaving in between the ribbon pieces. (P14a, P14b)
- Repeat for 2<sup>nd</sup> ribbon color. (P15a, P15b)
- Repeat steps if you are adding more ribbon.

#### Finishing the Craft

 Flip the cardboard piece over and tape the ends to the back to secure. (P16a, P16b)

You now have visual representation of a piece of fabric that has red and green in the warp and weft depicting tzara'at or uncleanness.


