
### Materials:


- · Cardstock white & color of choice
- Sequins (for grapes)
- Puffy paint blue (for cloud & tunic), black (for cracked ground), brown (for dried grapes), gold (for lion mane & Dwelling Place), red (for blood), yellow (for dress), silver (for spear, sword & high pillar)
- Wheat kernels
- Double-sided foam adhesive
- Tweezers (to help hold small items)
- Toothpick (for assisting in applying puffy paint)
- X-acto knife
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & Cover (BW) or Main Page & Cover (color)

### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Main Page of choice on white cardstock.
- · Print Cover on cardstock color of choice.

## Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- Using an X-acto knife, cut out all the doors for the blessing side and the curses side. (P1)
- Using a ruler, fold all the doors at the indicated lines so you have 2 openings for each one. (P2a, P2b)

### Embellishing the Sections

 You can choose to either just color the pages or embellish them with items such as we have recommended below.

## Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

#### Section 1

- Using blue puffy paint, add texture to the BLESSINGS of rain clouds. (P3a)
- Using black puffy paint and a toothpick, draw lines on the CURSES dry cracked ground. (P3b)
- Allow to dry. (P4)

### Section 2

- Apply glue on the BLESSINGS of the healthy and full grape clusters. (P5a)
- Add purple or maroon overlapping sequins onto the glue to create a 3-D effect. (P5b)
- Using brown puffy paint and a toothpick for placement, add dimension to the CURSES dried grapes. (P5c)
- Allow to dry. (P6)

### Section 3

- · Apply glue on the BLESSINGS of healthy wheat stalks. (P7a)
- Using tweezers for placement, lay wheat stalks or seeds on the glue. (P7b)
- · Apply glue on the CURSES of the thin wheat stalk. (P7c)
- Using tweezers for placement, lay a thin strand of a wheat stalk or seed on the glue. (P7d)
- Allow to dry. (P8)

# Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

### Section 4

- Using blue puffy paint, add dimension to the man resting in peace under the tree for the BLESSINGS and the man running from the shaking leaves for the CURSES. (P9)
- Allow to dry. (P10)

### Section 5

- Using brown puffy paint and a toothpick for placement, add dimension to the BLESSINGS of the tame dog. (P11a)
- Using gold puffy paint, add dimension to the CURSES of the wild lion. (P11b)
- Allow to dry. (P12)

### Section 6

- Using red puffy paint, add dimension to the BLESSINGS of the Yisra'elites prevailing over their enemies. (P13a)
- Using silver puffy paint and a toothpick for placement, add dimension to the CURSES of the enemy's sword and spear. (P13b)
- Allow to dry. (P14)

## Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

### Section 7

- Using yellow puffy paint, add dimension to the BLESSINGS of the pregnant woman's dress and the CURSES of the mourning woman's dress. (P15)
- Allow to dry. (P16)

### Section 8

- Using gold puffy paint and a toothpick for placement, add dimension to the columns of the BLESSINGS of the tabernacle in their midst. (P17a)
- Using silver puffy paint and a toothpick for placement, add dimension to the CURSES of the knocked down high pillar. (P17b)
- Allow to dry. (P18)
- Your Main Page is now finished. (P19)

We chose the word Keri which means contrary or hostile because Yahweh warned the children of Yisra'el over and over in Chapter 26 if they walked contrary to Him, then He would walk contrary to them. Our Notebook Page depicts what happens when one walks contrary to Him and when one walks with Him. Read verses 23-24. 27-28, 40-41 and discuss which pictures represent those who walked with Yahweh and received the Blessings and those who walked contrary (keri) to Yahweh and received the Curses. You may even look up what the word contrary means to get more understanding of what Yahweh meant and just how important it is to NOT walk hostile, contrary, opposed or against Him. In a future parsha Ki Tavo we will look at more BLESSINGS and CURSES that Yahweh spoke to the children of Yisra'el about in Deuternomy 28.

### Finishing the Page

- Place double-sided foam dimensionals on the corners of the Main Page. (P24)
- Place Doors Page over the Main Page making sure to line up all sides evenly. (P25)
- Each door can be opened to reveal a matching BLESSING and CURSES image. (P26a, P26b)

You now have a visual representation of some of the Blessings and Curses that Yahweh told Mosheh to speak to the children of Yisra'el about as an admonishment to NOT walk contrary to Him in order to avoid the CURSES, but to walk with Him to receive the BLESSINGS.
