In this week's Parsha Pearls lesson, we will be discussing some of the laws and the right-rulings Yahweh gave Yisra'el, along with His promised blessings for obedience and His curses for disobedience. Now, let's read Lev. 26.

- lay your land waste, so that the enemies dwelling among you are astonished - 26:32

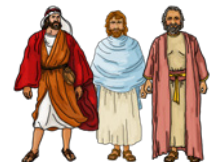

- the land - 26:42
- His covenant with Ya'aqob, Yitshaq and Abraham - 26:42
- the covenant of the ancestors whom He brought out of the land of Mitsrayim - 26:45



# DIGGING DEEPER

Parents/Teachers may choose to use these prompts for further discussion of the Torah portion.

- Parsha Bechukotai contains a series of blessings (26:3-13) and curses (26:14-46). Eleven verses are dedicated to blessings, while thirty six verses are dedicated to curses. Why do you think there are more curses than blessings? Can you find verses in the Scriptures that talk about the purpose of chastisement? Look at Deuteronomy 28 for further discussion on blessings and curses that Yahweh pronounces upon Yisra'el.
- Discuss how you would act if you knew Yahweh was giving you a choice between the blessings or the curses found in parsha Bechukotai and Ki Tavo.
- The Hebrew word for rebuke is 'chechah'. What is it that Yahweh does NOT want us to do if we wish to avoid rebuke from Him? Look at Lev. 26:14-15, 18, 21, 23, 27, 43. What is it that Yahweh wants us to do? Look at Lev. 26:2-3, 40-41.
- Why do you think Yahweh said that He would scatter or disperse Yisra'el among the nations? Do you think it might be because if they were concentrated in one area, their enemies might make war on them and annihilate them? (Lev. 26:33)

# Instructions for the Notebook Page cont'd:

## Section 1

- Using blue puffy paint, add texture to the BLESSINGS of rain clouds. (P3a)
- Using black puffy paint and a toothpick, draw lines on the CURSES dry cracked ground. (P3b)

## Section 2

- Apply glue on the BLESSINGS of the healthy and full grape clusters. (P5a)
- Add purple or maroon overlapping sequins onto the glue to create a 3-D effect. (P5b)
- Using brown puffy paint and a toothpick for placement, add dimension to the CURSES dried grapes. (P5c)

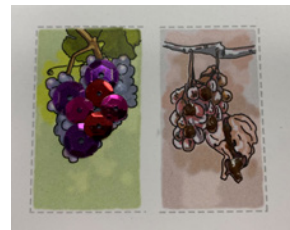

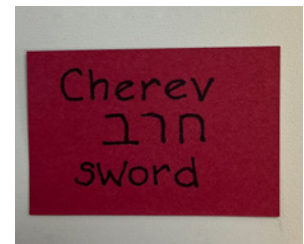

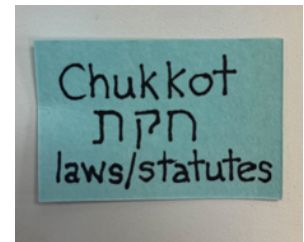

We chose the word Keri which means contrary or hostile because Yahweh warned the children of Yisra'el over and over in Chapter 26 if they walked contrary to Him, then He would walk contrary to them. Our Notebook Page depicts what happens when one walks contrary to Him and when one walks with Him. Read verses 23-24, 27-28, 40-41 and discuss which pictures represent those who walked with Yahweh and received the Blessings and those who walked contrary (keri) to Yahweh and received the Curses. You may even look up what the word contrary means to get more understanding of what Yahweh meant and just how important it is to NOT walk hostile, contrary, opposed or against Him. In a future parsha Ki Tavo we will look at more BLESSINGS and CURSES that Yahweh spoke to the children of Yisra'el about in Deuteronomy 28.

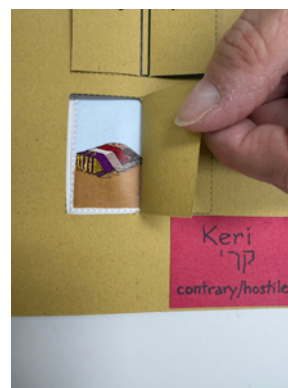

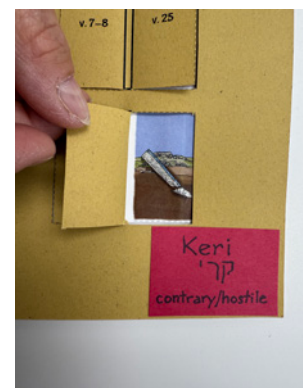
## Finishing the Page

## Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Your cover can turn to reveal some of the Blessings and Curses found in Leviticus 26.
  - **26:4** reveals the rain in its season and the land yielding its crops and **26:19** reveals the dry arid land that looks bronze. (P6)
  - **26:5** reveals the grape harvest as well as the bread to satisfaction and **26:20** reveals a lacks of good crops and fruit. (P7)
  - **26:6** reveals one laying down in peace by a tree and **26:36** reveals one running away from a shaking leaf. (P8)
  - **26:6** reveals a friendly dog as Yahweh clears the land of evil beasts and **26:22** reveals the wild beasts that Yahweh sent. (P9)
  - **26:9** reveals a woman that is fruitful and **26:22** reveals a woman that is bereaving the loss of her child. (P10)
  - **26:10** reveals a family that has abundance of food and **26:26** reveals a family lacking in food. (P11)
  - **26:11** reveals Yahweh's Dwelling Place in their midst and **26:30** reveals Yahweh cutting down their pagan sun-pillars. (P12)

# SWEET TASTE OF TORAH

This snack relates to this week's parsha. Please take these as suggestions and make necessary changes based on your individual dietary needs.

## Swords

Lev. 26:6-8, 33, 36-37



### Grape Sword Ingredients:

- Shish kabob skewer (to insert grapes into)
- Grapes (any color - represents blade)
- Aluminum foil (represents handle)

### Instructions:

Take your grapes and insert them into the skewer, filling up the top. Wrap foil around bottom of skewer to look like a handle.

### Pretzel Sword Ingredients:

- Pretzel stick (represents sword)
- Grape cut in half (represents handle)

### Instructions:

Take the half grape and insert it into pretzel stick at the bottom to represent sword handle.

### Celery or Carrot Sword Ingredients:

- Celery or carrot
- Optional: cream cheese or peanut butter for the celery
- Tiny skewers - to hold celery and carrot together

### Instructions:

Slice the celery and/or carrot to desired length of sword and handle. Slide the smaller piece horizontally down the skewer. Next, slide the longer piece on vertically.
