In this week's Parsha Pearls lesson, we will look at the testing of the children of Yisra'el because of a severe lack of water to drink, and how Yahweh miraculously provided the waters of Meribah. We will consider the actions of Mosheh and Aharon at the rock and their consequences. In this parsha we will also witness the death of Miryam and Aharon, and how the mantle of the High Priest is transferred to Aharon's son El'azar. Now, let's read Numbers 20:1-13, 22-29.

PEARL SEEKENB

- The children of Yisra'el travel to the Wilderness of Tsin at Qadesh, where Miryam dies and is buried - 20:1
- The congregation assembles against Mosheh and Aharon because there is no water (mayim) there for them to drink - 20:2
- The people contend with Mosheh, saying (20:3-5):
 - If only we had died before Yahweh along with the others!
 - Why did you bring us into this wilderness, so that we and our livestock should die here?
 - > Why did you bring us out of Mitsrayim to this evil place?
 - > There is no grain or figs or vines or pomegranates
 - > There is no water to drink
- Mosheh and Aharon approach the door of the Tent of Appointment and fall on their faces, and Yahweh's esteem appears before them - 20:6



PARSHA POINTS

PEARL SEEKENG

- Yahweh addresses Mosheh, saying (20:7-8):
 - > Take the rod, and you and Aharon assemble the congregation
 - > Speak (daber) to the rock (sehlah) before their eyes, and it shall give out water
 - > You shall bring water out of the rock, to provide drink for the congregation and their livestock
- Mosheh takes the rod, as Yahweh had commanded, and assembles the congregation before the rock 20:9-10
- Mosheh labels the people rebels, and demands to know if he should bring water out
 of the rock for them 20:10
- Mosheh then lifts his hand and strikes the rock twice with his rod 20:11
- Water gushes out of the rock for the people and their livestock to drink 20:11
- Although the miracle has happened, Yahweh reprimands Mosheh and Aharon for showing that they did not believe Him, and for failing to set Yahweh apart in the eyes of the children of Yisra'el - 20:12
- Yahweh pronounces His judgment; Mosheh and Aharon will NOT be the ones to lead the assembly into the land of promise - 20:12
- Because the children of Yisra'el contended with Yahweh over their lack of water, the place where the waters were given is called Meribah (place of strife/quarreling) -20:13
- The children of Yisra'el depart from Qadesh and arrive at Mount Hor 20:22
- Yahweh reveals to Mosheh that Aharon's life and ministry are now at an end; he will NOT enter the land, because they both had rebelled against Yahweh's mouth at the water of Meribah - 20:24
- Yahweh instructs Mosheh to bring Aharon and his son El'azar up to Mount Hor -20:25
- Yahweh has Mosheh remove Aharon's priestly garments and put them on El'azar, for it is time for Aharon to be gathered to his people and die there on the mountain -20:26
- Mosheh transfers the priestly garments from Aharon to El'azar, then Aharon dies on top of the mountain. Mosheh and El'azar come down from the mountain without him -20:28
- When all the congregation sees that Aharon is gone, they mourn his death for thirty days - 20:29



PARSHA POTUTS

DIEBINE DEEDER

Parents/teachers may choose to use these prompts for further discussion of the Torah portion. This section would be ideal for the Katan B and Gadol students for deeper study.

- In this parsha, the children of Yisra'el grumbled yet again about lack of water, and demanded that Mosheh provide it. Discuss Mosheh's actions when he failed to obey Yahweh's instruction to speak to the rock, but instead struck the rock-not just once, but twice.
- Consider that Mosheh had spent forty years hearing the congregation complain to him about everything, and accuse him every time something went wrong. How would you react?
- Notice how Mosheh responded to their complaint this time: "Shall WE bring water for you out of this rock?" Do you think perhaps Mosheh had gotten a little too 'full of himself'? Or do you think his actions were just a momentary reaction after many years of 'wear and tear' in dealing with a stiff-necked people?
- Knowing that Yahweh sees into the hearts of men, do you think His decision not to allow Mosheh and Aharon to lead the people into Kena'an was fair?

Notebook Page Instructions

Water From the Rock Numbers 20:11

Materials:

- Card stock white (2)
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- White glue
- Hot glue
- Scissors
- Brad (paper fastener)
- Tooth pick
- Craft foam scraps
- Butcher paper or a brown paper sack (mountain and rock)
- Silver foil shreds (water)
- Clear tape
- Pen
- Optional: dimensional paint
- Notebook Templates: Main Page and A




Parent/Teacher preparation:

Print both templates on white card stock.

Instructions for the notebook page:

- Color both templates.
- The Main Page can be decorated with sun, grass, trees, tents or in any way you want for a nice background, etc. Use dimensional paint to add to the background like we did for the sun. (P1)
- The front section where the mountain is, does not have to be painted. It will be covered with the butcher paper.
- Set page aside.
- Cut out all the pieces from Notebook Template A.
- Set Aharon and the crowd aside. (P2)
- Poke a hole through the 'x' in Mosheh's shoulder and Mosheh. Go in a circular motion so when you have the arms assembled they will be able to move.





Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the notebook page:

- Push a brad through all the holes in the following order: (P3)
 - > First, through the arm that is straight
 - > Second, through Mosheh's shoulder
 - > Last, through the bent arm
- Open the legs of the brad through the back to hold in place.
- Check the arms to make sure that they can move, mainly the bent arm.
- Take the toothpick and break off the pointed ends (this is for safety).
- Glue the toothpick on Mosheh's hand of the bent arm. Set it aside. (P4)
- Cut (2) long strips of your craft foam to glue to the bottom back of the crowd. If you only have short scrap pieces, that will work too.
- Glue (1) strip down at the bottom of the crowd section on the back.
- Glue the second strip on top of the last strip. (P5)
- This will raise the crowd from the paper.
- · Set it aside.
- Next, you will be creating some mountain pieces from the butcher paper or paper sack. It can be done free hand as it does not have to be exact, or you can print the main template on regular copy paper and cut the large piece and the small piece apart and use them as templates. Make sure that the pieces are bigger than the actual mountain pieces. (P6)
- Once cut, crumble the pieces really well so that there are a lot of creases on the paper. (P7)
- To give the brown paper a more 'rocky' look, take a brown marker and turn it sideways and color across your mountain pieces so only the raised sections will get color. (P8)













Notebook Page - page 3:

Instructions for the notebook page:

- Set the large piece aside.
- Take the smaller piece and cut a vertical slit about halfway on the piece. This will create a flap for the 'water' to come through. (P9)
- Take some strands of the silver foil shreds and fold them in half.
 Cut loops on one the end. (P10)
- Take the end in your hand and tape it to the back of the small piece on the wide side, on the right. (P10)
- Set the piece aside.
- Cut a couple of rectangle pieces from the left over scraps
 of Notebook Template A, large enough to write the
 Hebrew words for this week.
- Write: (P11)
 - 1) Selah 2) סלע 3) Rock
 - 1) Mayim 2) מים 3) Water
- Optional: color and trim the papers to look like rocks.

Assembling page:

- Put some glue on the larger section of the outline of the mountain and on the sides. (P12)
- Take the large mountain piece and glue it in place. Scrunch it or crease it in some places to fit the page. This will make it stand out. (P13)
- Glue the bottom of the mountain in place.
- Follow the first two steps for the smaller mountain piece to glue it in place. DO NOT glue the bottom.
- Move the foil and push it to the left side, out of the way of the flaps. (P14)
- Take the right flap and turn it out, just enough to put glue on the edges. (P15)
- Glue down to the page.
- The other flap will be left loose. Push the foil, twist it and push it into the smaller rock piece to hide it.
- Take the crowd piece and put glue on the foam. Glue the piece in place to the bottom of the page. (P16)

Notebook Page - page 4:

Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

- Glue the Hebrew word pieces in place, making sure the word 'mayim' is under the small mountain piece. The other word can be glued anywhere on the mountain. (P17) (P18)
- Glue the feet of Aharon about halfway up the mountain. (P19)
- Glue the feet of Mosheh close to the small mountain piece. (P19)

This is a visual representation of the event that took place, when the children of Yisra'el grumbled about not having water at Meribah and Mosheh striking the rock. Mosheh's arm can be moved to look like he is striking the rock and the flap on the small mountain piece can be moved out of the way so the 'water' can flow down. (P20)
