
- · Cardstock white
- Toothpick represents rod
- Brads medium & small
- X-acto knife
- Puncturing tool
- Ruler
- Double-sided foam dimensionals
- Double-sided tape
- Glue dots or glue
- Coloring pencils, crayons, or markers
- Notebook Page Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

• Print Notebook Page Template of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.
- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Using an X-acto knife, make a slit in the dotted lines on the Main Page. (P2)

Connecting Bil'am and Donkey Legs

- Using a puncturing tool, poke holes through the circles on Bil'am and the donkey's body, the right arm and the donkey's legs. (P3a, P3b)
- Using a small brad, connect Bil'am's arm to his shoulder—make sure to place the arm in front of Bil'am's shoulder. (P4)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Using 2 small brads, connect the donkey's legs to his body—make sure to place the legs behind the donkey. (P5a, P5b)
- Place a glue dot or glue onto Bil'am's hand and lay a toothpick on it. You will need to shorten the toothpick. (P6)

Creating the Main Page

- Add foam dimensionals to the back of the Messenger and then place on the Main Page in between the rocks. (P7a, P7b)
- Using a ruler to assist you, create the folds on the tabs of the vineyard and the stone wall. (P8a, P8b, P8c)
- Run double-side tape onto the tabs of the vineyard and the stone wall. (P9a, P9b)
- Adhere the vineyard and the stone wall onto the Main Page where indicated. (P10)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

Connecting Bil'am to the Main Page


 Insert a longer brad through the hole on Bil'am's waist and the slit on the Main Page making sure that he can slide up and down the slit. (P11a, P11b)

Hebrew Word

- Write the following directly onto the Main Page or a piece of colored cardstock and glue to the page: (P12)
 - > 1) Balak
- 2) בלק
- 3) Devastator
- Bil'am and his donkey may be placed on the different sections where Bil'am's donkey tried to stop Bil'am from going forward. (P13a, P13b)
- The donkey can lay down at the end where the Messenger can be seen by Bil'am. (P14)

You now have a visual representation of Bil'am riding his loyal donkey that saved him from being killed by the Messenger.
