## TREASURING HIS WORD

Let's do a quick overview of the entire Torah portion:

Monday:	Num. 25:10-18	The zeal of Phineas (Pinchas)
Tuesday:	Num. 26:1-27:11	A new census; The daughters of Tselophhad
Wednesday:	Num. 27:12-23	Yehoshua appointed Mosheh's successor
Thursday:	Num. 28	Daily, Sabbath and New Moon Offerings; Offerings for Spring Festivals
Friday:	Num. 29:1-30:1	Offerings for Fall Festivals

In this week's Parsha Pearls lesson, we will continue our study on offerings by looking at the different offerings that Yahweh required of Yisra'el on each of His Appointed Times as sweet offerings to Him. It may be helpful to restudy the Parsha Pearls lessons for Vayikra and Tzav, which explain the various kinds of offerings. Now, let's read Num. 28-29.

## PARSHA POINTS

- Yahweh told Mosheh to command the children of Yisra'el to take heed to bring His offerings at their appointed time (**moed**) - 28:1-2

### Daily Offerings

- Burnt Offering (28:3-4, 6-7):
  - 2 (**shtayim**) male lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - Prepare the first lamb in the morning, and the second one between the evenings
  - These are continual ascending offerings made by fire (**ishah**), a sweet (**nichoach**) fragrance (**re'ach**), just as they were offered at Mt. Sinai
- Grain Offering (28:5):
  - 1/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour mixed with 1/4<sup>th</sup> of a hin of pressed oil is to be offered with the morning lamb, and again with the afternoon lamb
- Drink Offering (28:7):
  - 1/4<sup>th</sup> of a hin of wine is to be offered with each lamb
  - It was to be poured out in the Set-apart Place as an offering to Yahweh



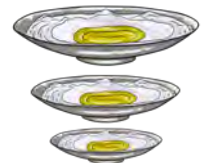
## Sabbath Offerings

- Burnt Offering (28:9-10):
  - 2 lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - These are continual ascending offerings made by fire, a sweet fragrance to Yahweh for every Sabbath
- Grain Offering (28:5):
  - 2/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil - 28:9
- Drink Offering (28:9-10):
  - 1/4<sup>th</sup> of a hin of wine for each lamb - 28:9-10
- The Sabbath offering was in addition to the daily offering and its grain and drink offering - 28:10



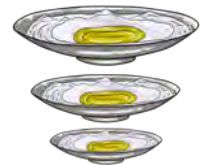
## New Moon Offerings

- Burnt Offering (28:11, 14):
  - 2 young bulls
  - 1 (**achat**) ram
  - 7 (**sheva**) lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - These are ascending offerings made by fire, a sweet fragrance to Yahweh for each new moon of the year
- Grain Offering (28:12-13):
  - 3/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each bull
  - 2/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for the 1 ram
  - 1/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each lamb
- Drink Offering (28:14):
  - 1/2 of a hin of wine for each bull
  - 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of a hin of wine for the 1 ram
  - 1/4<sup>th</sup> of a hin of wine for each lamb
- Sin Offering (28:15):
  - 1 male goat to make atonement for you



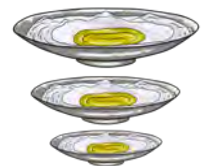
## ***Festival of Unleavened Bread Offerings***

- **Burnt Offering (28:19, 24):**
  - 2 young bulls
  - 1 ram
  - 7 lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - These are ascending offerings made by fire for 7 days, a sweet fragrance to Yahweh
- **Grain Offering (28:20-21):**
  - 3/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each bull
  - 2/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for the 1 ram
  - 1/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each lamb
- **Sin Offering (28:22):**
  - 1 male goat to make atonement for you
- The festival of Unleavened Bread offering is in addition to the daily offering and its grain and drink offering - 28:24



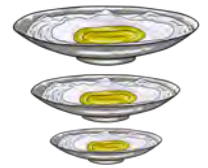
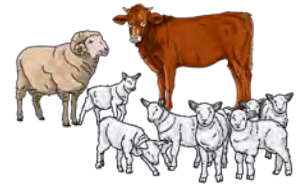

- **Burnt Offering (28:27):**
  - 2 young bulls
  - 1 ram
  - 7 lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - These are ascending offerings made by fire, a sweet fragrance to Yahweh
- **Grain Offering (28:28-29):**
  - 3/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each bull
  - 2/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for the 1 ram
  - 1/10<sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each lamb
- **Sin Offering (28:30):**
  - 1 male goat to make atonement for you
- The Shavuot offering is in addition to the daily offering and its grain and drink offering - 28:31



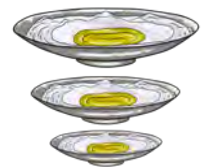
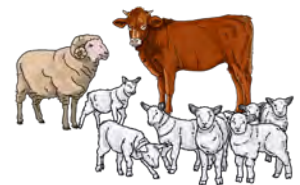

  - 1 young bull
  - 1 ram
  - 7 lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - These are ascending offerings made by fire, a sweet fragrance to Yahweh
- Grain Offering (29:3-4):
  - $\frac{3}{10}$ <sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each bull
  - $\frac{2}{10}$ <sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for the 1 ram
  - $\frac{1}{10}$ <sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each lamb
- Sin Offering (29:5):
  - 1 male goat to make atonement for you
- The Yom Teruah offering is in addition to the daily offering and its grain and drink offering and the New Moon offering - 29:6



## Yom HaKippurim Offering

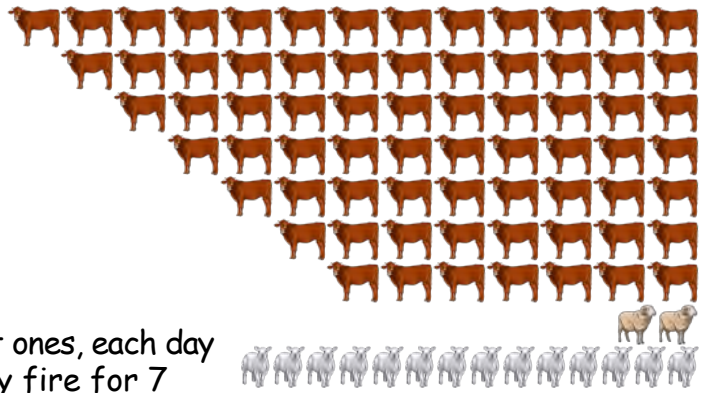

  - 1 young bull
  - 1 ram
  - 7 lambs a year old - perfect ones
  - These are ascending offerings made by fire, a sweet fragrance to Yahweh
- Grain Offering (29:9-10):
  - $\frac{3}{10}$ <sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each bull
  - $\frac{2}{10}$ <sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for the 1 ram
  - $\frac{1}{10}$ <sup>th</sup> of an ephah of fine flour, mixed with oil for each lamb
- Drink Offering (29:11):
  - $\frac{1}{2}$  of a hin of wine for each bull
  - $\frac{1}{3}$ <sup>rd</sup> of a hin of wine for the one ram
  - $\frac{1}{4}$ <sup>th</sup> of a hin of wine for each lamb
- Sin Offering (29:11):
  - 1 male goat to make atonement for you
- The Yom HaKippurim offering is in addition to the daily offering and its grain and drink offering and the sin offering - 29:11

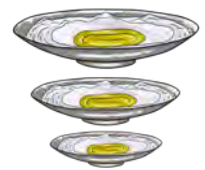

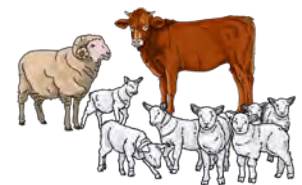

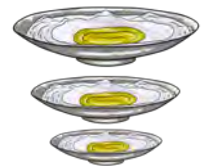

- 1 male goat to make atonement for you

- All these offering you prepare at their appointed times, besides your vow and voluntary offerings (peace offerings) - 29:39

- Mosheh told the children of Yisra'el all that Yahweh had spoken - 29:40

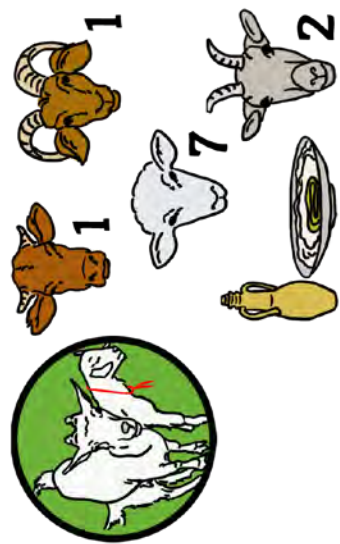
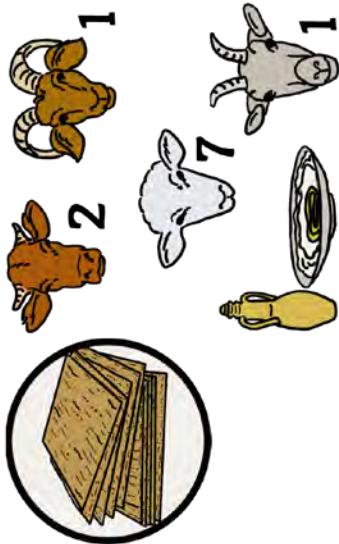
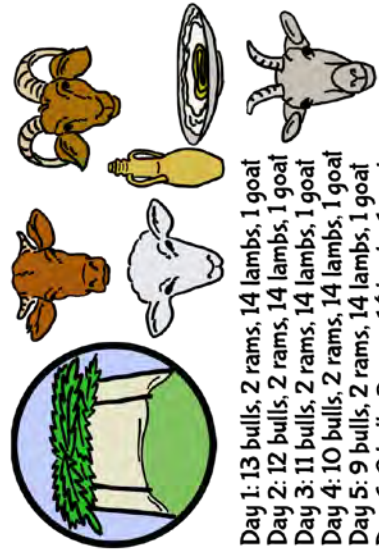
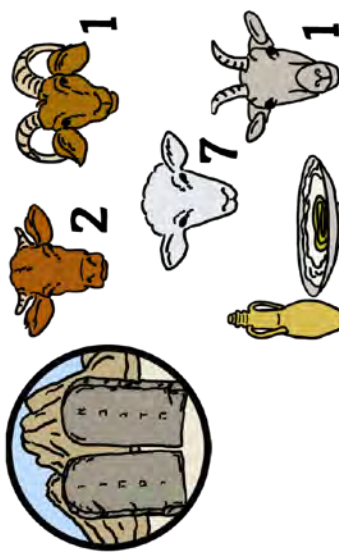
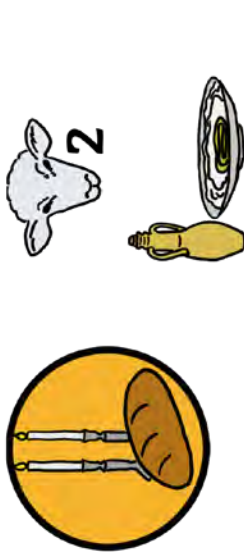
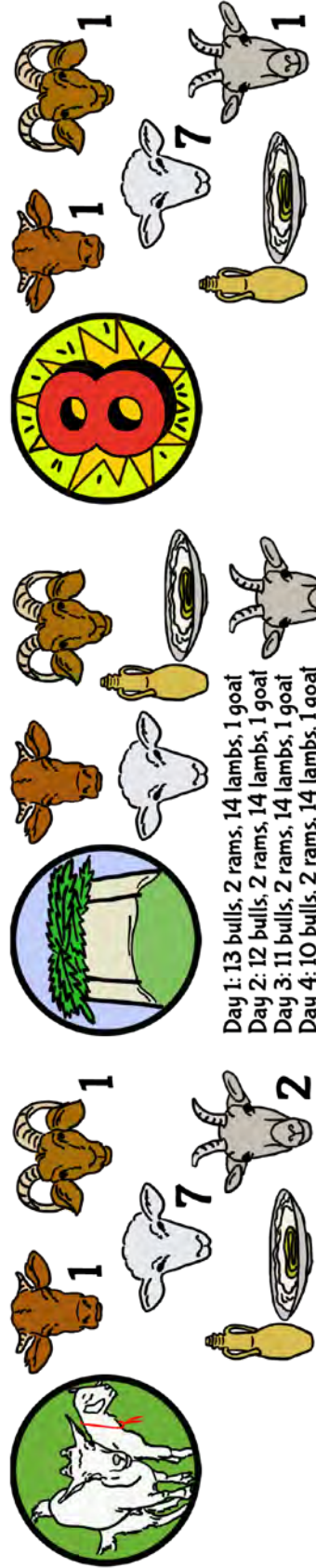
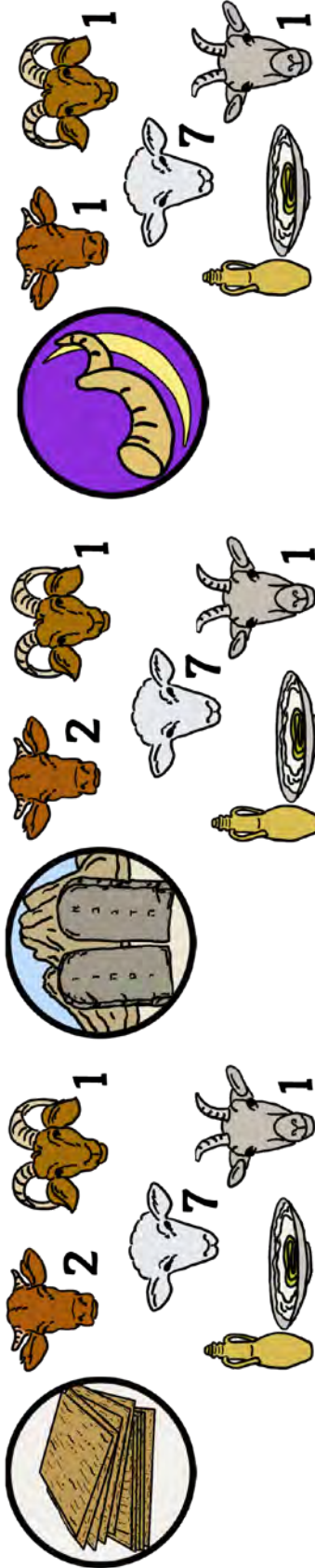
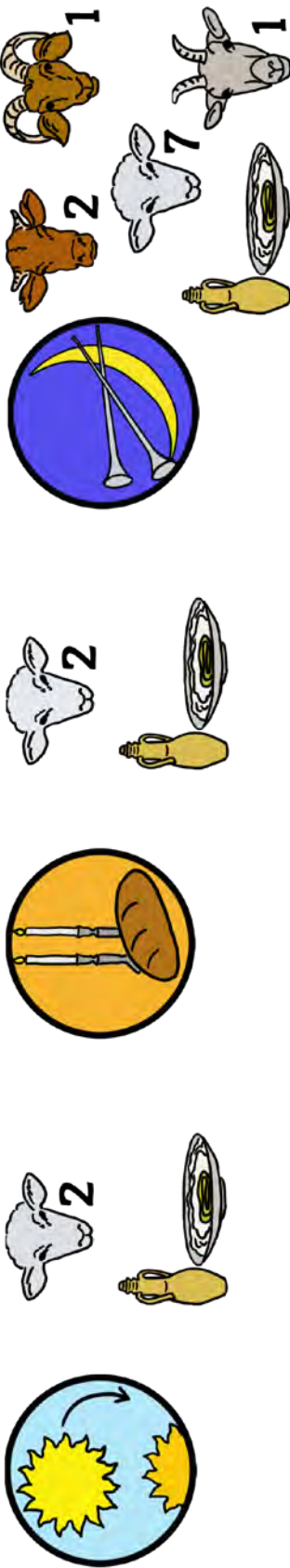
- Notice that the daily offering was offered in the morning and in the evening. Why do you think that is?
- Some religions teach that Yahweh prohibits alcohol. Research the Hebrew word for the type of drink offering Yahweh required for the daily offering. What is the Hebrew word for the type of drink offering Yahweh required for the New Moon?
- What is the significance of the number of animals that were sacrificed? For example, the number 7 is known as the number of completion. However, we see that on the first day of Sukkot, 13 bulls were to be sacrificed. Why do you think Yahweh asked for 13? Could it be that it included the Levites and the 12 tribes? How many total bulls were offered during Sukkot?

# SWEET TASTE OF TORAH

This snack relates to this week's parsha. Please take these as suggestions and make necessary changes based on your individual dietary needs.

## Offering Cookies

Numbers 28-29



### Ingredients:

- Animal cookie cutouts: bull, goat, lamb, ram
- $\frac{1}{4}$  c. vegetable shortening
- 1 c. sugar
- 1 egg
- 2 tsp. baking powder
- $\frac{1}{2}$  tsp. salt
- $2 \frac{1}{2}$  c. flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$  c. milk
- $\frac{1}{2}$  tsp. vanilla

### Instructions:

Cream vegetable shortening well. Add sugar and egg and blend together. Sift baking powder, salt and flour together. Add to cream mixture. Alternate with milk. Stir in vanilla. Chill for 3 hours.

Roll out the pastry  $\frac{1}{8}$  in. thick. Use cutouts to make appointed times animal shapes.

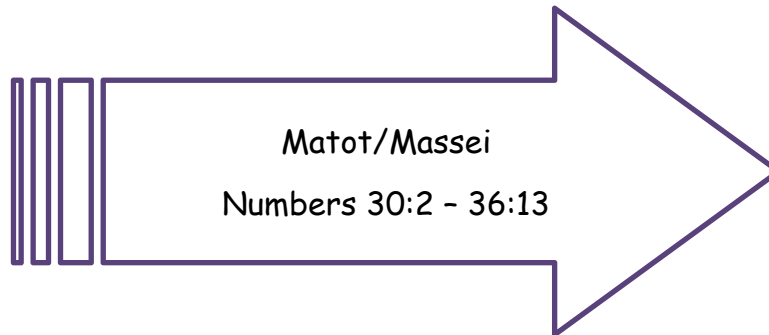
Bake at  $350^{\circ}\text{F}$  for 12 minutes.

Decorate animals with frostings, candy eyes, etc... if desired.
