## Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Adhere to the land on the Main Page as follows:
  - > Yisra'elite king with 1 wife, 1 horse, 1 bag of silver & gold, inside the land (P4a)
  - Pagan kings with lots of silver & gold, outside the land (P4b)
  - Pharaoh and Mitsrites which represent not going back to Mitsrayim, outside the land (P4c)
  - Pagan king with lots of horses, outside the land (P4d)
  - Pagan king with lots of wives, outside the land (P4e)
- Your page is now ready for the Hebrew Words. (P5)

#### Hebrew Words

- Write the following onto a piece of colored cardstock and glue to the page:
  - > 1) Melek 2) מלך (3) Sovereign/King (P6)
  - > 1) Nashim 2) دنه 3) Wives (P7)
  - > 1) Susim
    2) סוסים
    3) Horses (P8)
