

Precious Possessions

NOTEBOOK PAGE

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Wheat seeds or seeds of choice (to add dimension to the basket and wheat stalks)
- Puncturing tool
- Tiny brad
- Ruler (to assist in folding tabs)
- Double-sided adhesive tape
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons, or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)

First-Fruits

Deuteronomy 26:1-3, 10



Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the circle on the arm with basket and the shoulder of the offeror. (P2a, P2b)
- Using a brad, connect the 2 pieces, making sure to place the arm with basket under the shoulder. (P3)
- Apply glue onto the offeror's basket and the wheat stalks. (P4a, P4b)

Instructions for the Notebook

Page cont'd:

- Place wheat seeds or seeds of choice onto the glue to add dimension to the basket and wheat stalks. (P5)
- Allow to dry.
- Using a ruler to assist you, fold the tabs inward on the images. (P6a, P6b)

Adding the Characters to the Main Page

- Run double-sided adhesive tape onto the front of the tabs of the following images, and start adding to the Main Page as follows: (P7)
 - house - at the top of the map (P8a)
 - East gate - on the middle of the map (P8b)
 - priest - in front of the gate (P8c)
 - offeror with basket - to the left (P8d)
 - wheat stalks - in the foreground (P8e)
- Your page is now ready for the Hebrew Words. (P9)

Hebrew Words

- Write the following directly onto the Main Page or a piece of colored cardstock and glue to the page:
 - 1) **Tene** 2) **טנא** 3) **Basket** (P10)
 - 1) **Reshith P'ri** 2) **ראשית פרי** 3) **First-Fruits** (P11)

You now have a visual representation of the command to bring the first-fruits to the priest at the place where Yahweh Elohim puts His Name.



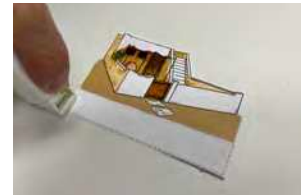

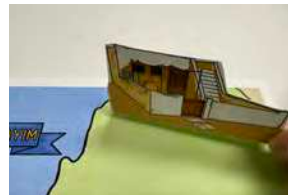

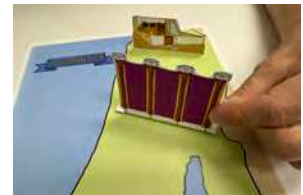
