Notebook Page Instructions

Pilgrimage Festivals Deuteronomy 16:16

Materials:

- Card stock white (3)
- Copy paper (3)
- Card stock Blue or color of choice (for Main Page) (1)
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Scissors
- White Glue
- Dimensional paint silver
- Pen
- Notebook Templates: A, B, C & D
- Parent/Teacher Preparation:
- Print 3 copies of Notebook Template A (map) on regular copy paper.
- Print Notebook Templates B-D on white card stock.


Instructions for the Notebook page:

- Color the maps on Notebook Template A to look exactly the same. (P1)
- Cut the maps close to the lines. You can stack the 3 maps so that they match and then cut them. (P1)
- Color the items on Notebook Template B-D. (P2)
- Fold the maps in half width wise. (P3)
- Separate the maps and begin gluing them together by putting the top back of one map with the bottom back of a second map. Repeat the process putting the top back of the second map with the bottom back of the third map. This will create 3 maps that are attached and can unfold separately. (P4)
- Alian the top of the third map to the top of your color card stock piece that you chose for the Main Page. (P5)
- Press down and then add glue to the bottom back of the first map.
- The maps will flip to reveal another map. (P5)


Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

- Each map will represent a different time when the men were required to travel for a feast (Pesach, Shavuot and Sukkot).
- Cut the rectangles that have the names of the different feasts and attach a different one to each map. (P6)
- Cut the cities, houses, people, animals and sukkah, making sure to not cut too close at the bottom so that you have enough extra card stock to make a stand
- Cut the shofar, matzah, sacks, loaves and lulav close to the lines.
- Using dimensional paint, make dots on the mouths of the sacks to make it look like silver coins in the sacks. Set aside to dry. (P7)
- Cut 2 small rectangles from your card stock scraps for the Hebrew words. Write: (P8)
 - 1) Ma'aser 2) מעשׂר 3) Tithe
 - 1) Chag Festival חג (2

Begin assembling page for Pesach (P9)

- Glue the city on the upper side of the fold on the map on the first map (Pesach).
- Glue the shofar to the High Priest. Glue the High Priest in front of the city.
- Glue 1 house at a distance from the city and 1 close to the city.
- Glue a matzah to the hands of the group of women and the other one to the single woman.
- Glue the single woman in front of 1 of the houses and the group of women in front of the other house. It doesn't matter which house.
- Choose 1 man to glue close to the city, traveling from the house near the city and the other man near the other house traveling from further away.
- Make a stand for the sack of silver by cutting a small strip, about $\frac{1}{2}$ " by $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the scraps of card stock.

Notebook Page - page 3:

Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

- Check to make sure the dimensional paint is dry. If it is, glue the stand on the back of the sack. Glue the sack near the man traveling from far away.
- Glue the animals close to the man traveling from close by.
- Carefully fold everything flat so it will enable turning to the next map (Shavuot).

Begin assembling page for Shavuot (P10)

- Repeat the steps given for Pesach for the city, houses, people, and sack, but glue the bread loaves on the man traveling from close by. No matzah for this map.
- Glue the rest of the animals close to the man traveling from close by.
- Carefully fold everything flat so the next map can be turned.

Begin assembling page for Sukkot (P11)

- Flip to the third map.
- Repeat the steps given for Pesach for the city, houses, people, and sack, but glue one lulav on the man traveling from close by and one on the one traveling far.
- Glue the animals close to the man traveling from close by.
- Glue the Sukkah somewhere on the board.
- Glue the Hebrew words on the Main Page.

This is a visual of the 3 times that men were required to travel to the place Yahweh your Elohim put His Name and some of the offerings required to be brought. P10
