CRAFT

Materials:

- · Copy paper
- Felt white & light green or color of choice for background
- Cotton swabs with the cotton removed (2)
- Double-sided tape
- · Hot glue
- Scissors
- Permanent marker black (ultra fine tip)
- · Craft Template: Torah Scroll (BW)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Template on copy paper.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to assist them in cutting out the Template and felt pieces.

Torah Scroll Felt Finger Puppet




Instructions for the Craft:

- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Place Template pieces on felt pieces, using double-sided tape to hold them in place if desired. Be sure to match each template piece to the color of felt designated on the template.
- Cut the felt pieces by cutting around the templates you have just placed on the felt. (P2)
- Using the black permanent marker, color one inch on each end of the 2 cotton swab sticks and set them aside. (P3)
- Apply glue to the edges of the 2 background pieces and put them together, making sure to leave an opening at the bottom. (P4)
- Hot glue the 2 cotton swab sticks to the ends of the white felt. (P5)
- Roll them inward to create a Torah scroll.
- Glue the Torah scroll onto the background. (P6)
- Set Torah scroll felt finger puppet aside to allow the glue to dry.

You now have a visual representation of a Torah scroll to reflect on our Messiah the walking talking living Torah.
