

CRAFT

Torah Scroll Finger Puppet

Materials:

- Copy paper
- Stiff felt - green, white
- Q-tips (2)
- Sponge brush (for painting Q-tips)
- Metallic paint - bronze or color of choice (for painting Q-tips)
- Double-sided tape (to hold template pieces while cutting)
- Hot glue
- Scissors
- Craft Template: Torah scroll (BW)




Parent/Teacher Preparation:


- Print Craft Template on copy paper.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to assist them in cutting out the Craft Template and felt pieces.

Instructions for the Craft:

- Cut out all Craft Template pieces, including the 'torah scroll image.' (P1)
- Place double-sided tape onto the back of the paper template pieces and lay over felt colors indicated. Cut around the templates you have just placed on the felt. (P2)
- Remove the paper templates from the felt pieces. Keep the paper 'torah scroll image' for reference in placement and drawing. (P3)
- Apply hot glue around the edges of the 'background back,' making sure to leave an opening at the bottom, and place the 'background front' over it. (P4a, P4b)
- Using a sponge brush, paint the Q-tips with metallic bronze paint (or color of choice). (P5)
- Set aside to dry. (P6)
- Apply a strip of hot glue to one end of the 'torah scroll' and place a Q-tip on the glue. (P7a, P7b)



Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Apply a strip of hot glue to the other end of the 'torah scroll' and place the second Q-tip on the glue. (P8a, P8b)
- Start rolling one end of the 'torah scroll' about 3-4 turns. (P9)
- Apply a strip of hot glue below the end of the rolled 'torah scroll' and roll the 'torah scroll' one more turn onto the glue. (P10)
- Apply a strip of hot glue below the other end of the rolled 'torah scroll' and roll the 'torah scroll' one more turn onto the glue. (P11a, P11b)
- Your 'torah scroll' is now completed. (P12)
- Apply 2 strips of hot glue on the back and ends of the 'torah scroll,' and place onto the 'background front,' referring to the 'torah scroll image' for placement. (P13a, P13b)
- Set the torah scroll finger puppet aside to dry.


You now have a visual representation of a Torah scroll to reflect on our Messiah the walking talking living Torah.






