

CRAFT

Yonah Finger Puppet

Materials:

- Copy paper
- Stiff felt - medium blue, medium brown, white, black, turquoise, skin tone (or colors of choice)
- Double-sided tape (to hold template pieces while cutting)
- Thin string - blue, white (for tzitzit)
- Hot glue
- Tweezers (to assist in placement)
- Scissors
- Permanent marker - black (fine tip)
- Craft Template: Yonah (BW)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Template on copy paper.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to assist them in cutting out the Craft Template and felt pieces.



Instructions for the Craft:

- Cut out all Template pieces, including the 'Yonah image' and 'face drawing.' (P1)
- Place double-sided tape onto the back of the paper template pieces and lay over felt colors indicated (or colors of choice). Cut around the templates you have just placed on the felt. (P2)
- Remove the paper templates from the felt pieces. Keep the paper 'Yonah image,' 'turban template,' 'hair and beard template,' and 'face drawing' for reference in placement or drawing. (P3)
- Apply hot glue around the edges of the 'body back' (medium blue), making sure to leave an opening at the bottom, and place the 'body front' (white) over it. (P4a, P4b)
- Apply hot glue on the back of the 'left & right robe,' and place onto the 'body front,' referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement. (P5a, P5b)

Instructions for the Craft cont'd:


- Cut 4 strands of white string and one strand of blue string about 1" long and place the blue string in the middle. Trim the white strands to be $\frac{1}{4}$ " shorter than the blue. (P6a, P6b)
- Place the tzitzit on the 'left & right robe,' referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement. (P7)
- Apply hot glue on the back of the 'belt' and place over the tzitzit and 'robe,' using tweezers if needed for assistance, referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement. (P8a, P8b)

*Please note that there will only be 2 tzitzit on Yonah as we are not doing the back of the felt puppet.

- Using hot glue, place the pieces onto the 'body front' in the following order, referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement:
 - back of the 'left & right arm' - don't add glue to the edge of the sleeves as the 'hands' will go under it (P9a, P9b)
 - front of the 'left & right hand' - just on the wrist - tuck wrists under edge of sleeves, using tweezers if needed for assistance (P9c, P9d)
- Using a fine tip black permanent marker, draw the fingers details, referring to the 'Yonah image' for assistance. (P10)

Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Apply hot glue on the top and sides of the 'head,' and place the 'hair and beard' onto the glue, referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement. (P11a, P11b)
- Apply hot glue on the back of the 'turban band' and place onto the 'turban,' referring to the 'turban template' for placement, using tweezers if needed for assistance. (P12a, P12b)
- Apply hot glue on the top of the 'hair,' and place the 'turban' onto the glue, referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement. (P13a, P13b)
- Using a fine tip black permanent marker, draw the mouth and face details, referring to the 'hair and beard template' and 'face drawing' for assistance. (P14a, P14b)
- Apply a circle of hot glue to the head area on the 'body front,' and place the completed head piece onto the glue, referring to the 'Yonah image' for placement. (P15a, P15b)
- Set the Yonah finger puppet aside to dry.

You now have a visual representation of Yonah.
