

CRAFT

Materials:

- Copy paper
- Stiff felt - green, white
- Q-tips (2)
- Metallic paint - bronze or color of choice (for painting Q-tips)
- Double-sided tape (to hold template pieces while cutting)
- Double-sided adhesive tape and/or hot glue
- Scissors
- Craft Template: Torah Scroll (BW)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

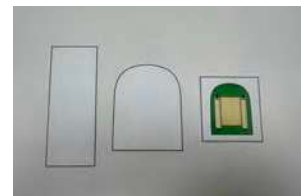
- Print Craft Template on copy paper.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to assist them in cutting out the Craft Template and felt pieces.
- In lieu of double-sided adhesive tape, you can use hot glue to assemble the puppet.

Torah Scroll Finger Puppet



Instructions for the Craft:

- Cut out all Template pieces, including the 'torah scroll image' for reference in drawing or placement. (P1)
- Place double-sided tape onto the back of the paper template pieces and lay over felt colors indicated. Cut around the templates you have just placed on the felt. (P2)
- Remove the paper templates from the felt pieces. (P3)
- Run double-sided adhesive tape around the edges of the 'background back,' making sure to leave an opening at the bottom, and place the 'background front' over it. (P4a, P4b)
- Squeeze metallic paint onto the Q-tips cotton part and slightly below only. (P5)
- Set aside to dry.

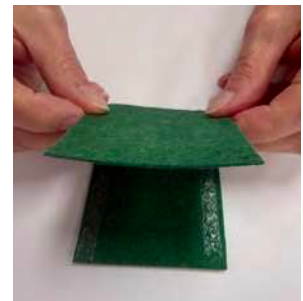

Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Apply a strip of hot glue to both ends of the 'torah scroll' and lay the *Q-tips* on the glue. (P6a, P6b, P6c)
- Roll one end of the 'torah scroll' about 3 turns and apply a strip of hot glue below the end of the rolled 'torah scroll.' Roll the 'torah scroll' one more turn onto the glue. (P7a, P7b)
- Roll the other end of the 'torah scroll' about 3 turns and apply a strip of hot glue below the end of the rolled 'torah scroll.' Roll the 'torah scroll' one more turn onto the glue. (P8a, P8b)
- Apply 2 strips of hot glue onto the back of the 'torah scroll,' where the *Q-tips* are and place onto the 'background front.' (P9a, P9b)
- The torah scroll finger puppet is now complete.

You now have a visual representation of a Torah scroll to reflect on our Messiah the walking talking living Torah.

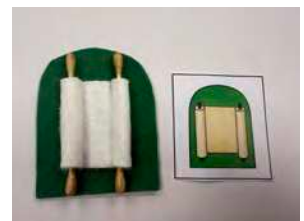
