

CRAFT

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Craft stick - jumbo
- Glitter glue - gold
- Puffy paint - red, green, brown
- Double-sided adhesive foam dimensionals
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Craft Template: Apple & Honey (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Template on white cardstock.
- Depending on the skill of the child, you may need to assist them in cutting out the Craft Template pieces.

Apple & Honey Stick Puppet



Instructions for the Craft:

- Cut out all Template, including the 'apple & honey image.' (P1)
- Apply glue to the back of the 'background back template' and lay the top 1/3 of a jumbo craft stick onto the glue. (P2)
- Apply glue to the top 1/3 of the jumbo craft stick and place the 'background front template' over it to connect the 2 pieces. (P3a, P3b)
- Adhere double-sided adhesive foam dimensionals to the back of the 'honey pot template' and 'apple template.' (P4)
- Place the 'honey pot template' on the 'background front template', referring to the 'apple & honey image' for placement. (P5)

Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Using gold glitter glue, embellish the 'honey pot template.' (P6)
- Allow to dry. (P7)
- Place the 'apple template' slightly to the right and bottom of the 'honey pot template,' referring to the 'apple & honey image' for placement. (P8)
- Using brown puffy paint for the stem, green puffy paint for the leaves, and red puffy paint for the apple, embellish them. (P9a, P9b, P9c)
- Allow to dry. (P10)
- The apple & honey stick puppet is now complete.

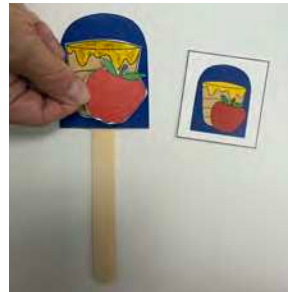
You now have a visual representation of a traditional food eaten on Yom Teruah - apples and honey.

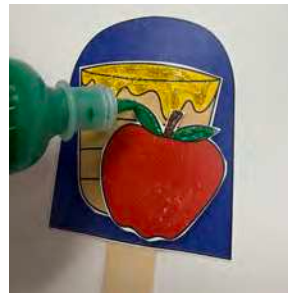
