## CRAFT

### Eagle

Deuteronomy 32:11

### Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Foam - brown or black, yellow, white (for foam version)
- Double sided adhesive foam dimensionals (for paper version)
- Glue & glue stick
- Scissors
- Marker or pen (to color in eye & trace templates onto foam)
- Craft Templates: A & B (BW) or C & D (color)

### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Templates on cardstock.

### Instructions for the Craft:

#### Paper Version

- Cut out all Craft Templates. (P1)
- Adhere a double-sided adhesive foam dimensional onto the back of the yellow beak and the eye and place on the eagle's face. (P2a, P2b)
- Run a glue stick along the oval on the top of the eagle's body and lay the eagle's face over the glue. (P3a, P3b)
- Adhere a double-sided adhesive foam dimensional onto the back of the eagle's claws and place on the bottom of the eagle's body. (P4a, P4b)
- Adhere a double-sided adhesive foam dimensional onto the front and top of the eagle's tail and place the eagle's face and body with claws over it. (P5a, P5b)
- Adhere double-sided adhesive foam dimensionals onto the front of the 'wrist' on both hands, and place the eagle over it to connect the eagle's wings. (P6a, P6b)



# Instructions for the Craft Cont'd:

## Foam Version

- Cut out all Craft Templates. (P1)
- Trace the 2 claws and beak onto yellow foam and cut out. (P2a, P2b)
- Trace the wings, body, and tail onto brown foam and cut out. (P3a, P3b)
- Trace the eagle face and eye onto white foam and cut out. (P4a, P4b)
- Color in the pupil with a black marker or pen. (P5)
- Run glue on the back of the eye and place on the eagle's head. (P6)
- Run glue on the back of the beak and place on the eagle's head. (P7)
- Run glue along the bottom and back of the eagle's head and place over the eagle's body. (P8a, P8b)
- Run glue along the top 1/3 of the eagle's tail on the front. (P9)
- Place the eagle's face and body over the glue. (P10)
- Run glue on the back side of the eagle's claws. (P11)
- Flip the claws over and place them on both sides of the eagle's body. (P12a, P12b)
- Run glue on the wings along the 'wrist' area. (P13)
- Place the eagle onto the glue to connect the eagle's wings. (P14a, P14b)


*You now have a visual representation of Yahweh's poetic depiction of Himself as an eagle that watches over Yisra'el.*




