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PARSHA POINTS

TREASURING HIS WORD

Let's do a quick overview of the Torah portion:

Monday:	Deut. 32:1-10	Mosheh's Song
Tuesday:	Deut. 32:11-20	Mosheh's Song
Wednesday:	Deut. 32:21-30	Mosheh's Song
Thursday:	Deut. 32:31-43	Mosheh admonishes the people; Yahweh instructs
Friday:	Deut. 32:44-52	Mosheh regarding his imminent death

In this week's Parsha Pearls lesson, we will examine the song that Yahweh gave Mosheh to teach the children of Yisra'el - a song that would always stand as a witness before them. To learn the context for this song, we will backtrack to the previous parsha. We will also hear Yahweh instruct Mosheh to climb Mt. Nebo and look at the land he is barred from entering, before his death. Now, let's read Deuteronomy 31:19-23, 30 & Chapter 32.

PEARL SEEKING

- Yahweh commanded Mosheh to write down a song for the children of Yisra'el and to teach it to them. They were supposed to learn it so that it might be a witness against them - 31:19

The Future

- Yahweh will bring the children of Yisra'el to the land flowing with milk and honey, which He swore to their fathers - 31:20
- There they shall (31:20):
 - eat and be satisfied and grow fat
 - turn to other mighty ones and serve them
 - scorn Yahweh and break His covenant
- When many evils and distresses come upon them, the song will remain before them as a witness - 31:21
- It shall not be forgotten in the mouths of their seed - 31:21

The Present

- Mosheh wrote the song the same day and taught it to the children of Yisra'el - 31:22



PARSHA POINTS

PEARL SEEKING

- Yahweh commanded Yehoshua son of Nun, "Be strong and courageous, for you are to bring the children of Yisra'el into the land of which I swore to them, and I Myself am with you." - 31:23
- Mosheh spoke the words of this song in the hearing of all the assembly of Yisra'el till their completion - 31:30

Chapter 32

- 1 "Give ear, O heavens, and let me speak; And hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.
- 2 Let my instruction fall as rain, my speech drop down as dew, as fine rain on the tender plants, and as showers on the grass.
- 3 For I proclaim the Name of Yahweh. Ascribe greatness to our Elohim.
- 4 The Rock (tzur)! His work is perfect, for all His ways are right-ruling, an El of truth and without unrighteousness, Righteous and straight is He.
- 5 A twisted and crooked generation has corrupted itself, their blemish, *they are not* His children.
- 6 Do you do this to Yahweh, O foolish and unwise people? Is He not your Father, who bought you, who created you and established you?
- 7 Remember the days of old. Consider the years of many generations. Ask your father and let him show you, your elders, and let them say to you:
- 8 When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance, when He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples according to the number of the children of Yisra'el.
- 9 For the portion of Yahweh is His people, Ya'aqob His allotted inheritance.
- 10 He found him in a wilderness, and in a wasted, howling desert. He encompassed him, He made him understand, He watched over him as the apple/pupil (ishon) of His eye.
- 11 As an eagle (neshar) stirs up its nest, flutters over its young, spreading out its wings (kanaph), taking them up, bearing them on its wings.
- 12 Yahweh alone led him, and there was no strange mighty one with him.
- 13 He made him ride in the heights of the earth, and he ate the fruit of the fields, and He made him to draw honey from the rock, and oil from the flinty rock,
- 14 Curds from the cattle, and milk of the flock, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the choicest wheat; and you drank wine, the blood of the grapes.



PARSHA POINTS

PEARL SEEKING

- 15 But Yeshurun (*meaning upright, just or straight - referring to Yisra'el*) grew fat and kicked; you grew fat, you grew thick, you are covered with fat; so he forsook Eloah who made him, and scorned the Rock of his deliverance.
- 16 They moved Him to jealousy with foreign matters, with abominations they provoked Him.
- 17 They slaughtered to demons - not Eloah - Mighty ones they did not know, new ones who came lately, which your fathers did not fear.
- 18 You neglected the Rock who brought you forth, and forgot the El who fathered you.
- 19 And Yahweh saw, and despised, because of the provocation of His sons and His daughters.
- 20 And He said, 'Let Me hide My face from them, let Me see what their end is. For they are a perverse generation, children in whom there is no trusting.
- 21 They made Me jealous by what is not El. They provoked Me with their worthless matters. But I make them jealous by those who are no people, I provoke them with a foolish nation.
- 22 For a fire was kindled in My wrath and burns to the bottom of She'ol (*grave*), and consumes the earth and its increase, and sets on fire the foundations of mountains.
- 23 I gather evils upon them, I use up My arrows upon them -
- 24 Wasted by scarcity of food, and consumed by heat and bitter destruction, and the teeth of beasts I send upon them, with the poison of serpents of the dust.
- 25 The sword bereaves from the outside, and fear from within, both young man and maiden, nursing child with the man of grey hairs.
- 26 I said, 'I should blow them away, I should make the remembrance of them to cease from among men,
- 27 'If I did not fear the enemy's taunt, lest their adversaries misunderstand, lest they say, "Our hand is high, and Yahweh has not done all this." '
- 28 For they are a nation lost to counsel, and there is no understanding in them.
- 29 If they were wise, they would understand this, they would consider their latter end!
- 30 How would one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, unless their Rock had sold them, and Yahweh had given them up?
- 31 For their rock is not like our Rock - Even our enemies are judges.
- 32 Their vine is of the vine of Sedom (Sodom), and of the fields of Amarah (Gomorrhah); their grapes are grapes of gall, their clusters are bitter.
- 33 Their wine is the poison of serpents, and the fierce venom of cobras.



PARSHA POINTS

PEARL SEEKING

- 34 'Is it not stored up with Me, sealed up among My treasures?
- 35 'Vengeance is Mine, and repayment, at the time their foot slips; For near is the day of their calamity, and the matters prepared are hastening to them.'
- 36 For Yahweh rightly rules His people and has compassion on His servants, when He sees that their power is gone, and there is no one remaining, shut up or at large.
- 37 And He shall say, 'Where are their mighty ones, the rock in whom they sought refuge?
- 38 'Who ate the fat of their slaughterings, and drank the wine of their drink offering? Let them arise and help you, let it be a hiding-place for you!
- 39 'See now that I, I am He, and there is no Elohim besides Me. I put to death and I make alive. I have wounded, and I heal. And from My hand no one delivers!
- 40 'For I lift My hand to the heavens, and shall say: As I live forever,
- 41 'If I have sharpened My flashing sword, and My hand takes hold on judgment, I shall return vengeance to My enemies, and repay those who hate Me.
- 42 'I make My arrows drunk with blood, and My sword devours flesh, with the blood of the slain and the captives, from the long-haired enemy chiefs.'
- 43 "O nations, acclaim His people! For He avenges the blood of His servants, and returns vengeance to His adversaries, and shall pardon His land, His people."

- Mosheh then spoke this song along with Yehoshua, son of Nun in the hearing of the people - 32:44
- Mosheh tells the children of Yisra'el, "Set your heart on all the words with which I warn you today, so that you command your children to guard to do all the Words of this Torah. For it is not a worthless Word for you, because it is your life, and by this Word you prolong your days on the soil which you pass over the Yarden to possess." - 32:46-47
- Yahweh tells Mosheh to go up Mount Nebo and look at the land of Kena'an which He is giving to the children of Yisra'el as a possession - 32:49
- Mosheh will die on this mountain and be gathered to his people, as Aharon his brother died on Mount Hor and was gathered to his people - 32:50
- He is not to enter the land because he trespassed against Yahweh in the midst of the children of Yisra'el at the waters of Meribah Qadesh, in the Wilderness of Tsin, and did not set Yahweh apart in the midst of the children of Yisra'el - 32:51
- Mosheh is to look at the land, but not enter there, into the land which Yahweh is giving to the children of Yisra'el - 32:52



PARSHA POINTS

DIGGING DEEPER

Parents/Teachers may choose to use these prompts for further discussion of the Torah portion. This section would be ideal for the Katan B and Gadol students for deeper study.

- What is the tone of Yahweh's song? Yahweh says He is our Father and we are His children. (32:6, 18-20) Can you picture a father talking this way to his child who is struggling between right and wrong choices? Find other verses comparing our relationship with Yahweh as a Father with His child.
- When Yahweh says that He is a Rock, what does this mean? (32:4, 15, 18, 30-31) Find other Bible verses that talk about Yahweh being our Rock.
- Discuss the attributes of Yahweh that are mentioned in 32:4 - perfect, truth, righteous, straight. Now look at verse 5; do we show Yahweh the same attributes in return?
- What does it mean to be the 'apple of someone's eye'? (32:10) Is this an intimate and close relationship?
- Find other references to Yeshurun in the Scriptures. (32:15) What does it mean when Yahweh says Yisra'el grew fat? Could it be that they became satisfied and self-reliant? Did they forget that all their abundance came from Yahweh? Discuss the irony that Yahweh calls Yisra'el Yeshurun (upright) when they are straying.
- Do we see evidence in this song of the same consequences that will come upon Yisra'el for straying from His commands in the blessings and curses chapter of Leviticus 26? (32:15-43)
- Mosheh wrote another song, found in Exodus 15:1-18. Read it and discuss the differences between the 2 songs. Now read Revelation 15:3-4, which also mentions The Song of Mosheh. Discuss the importance of these verses.

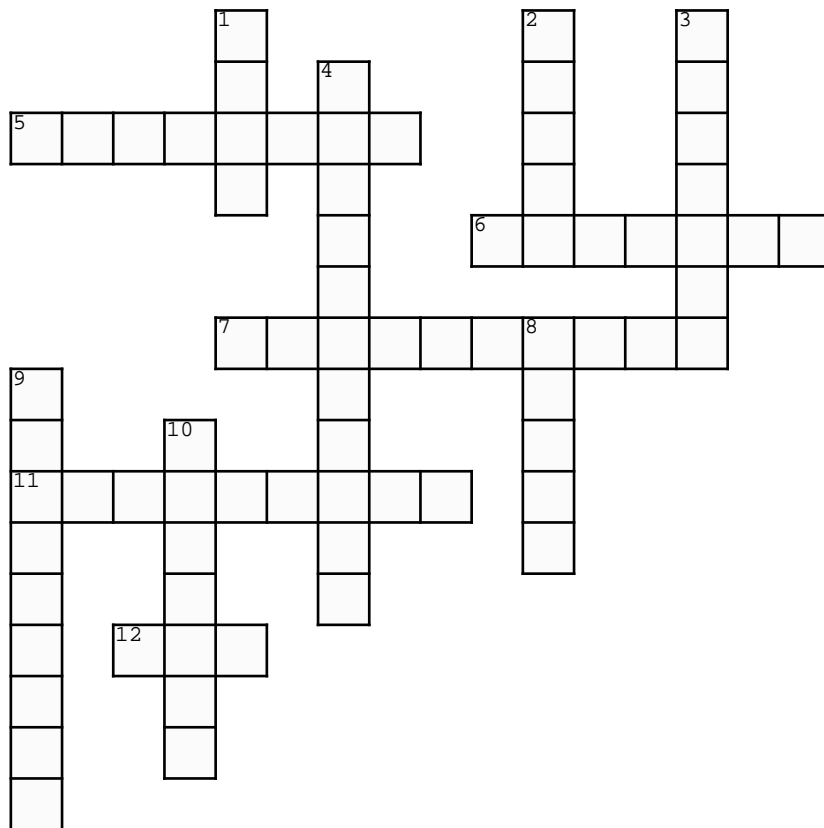

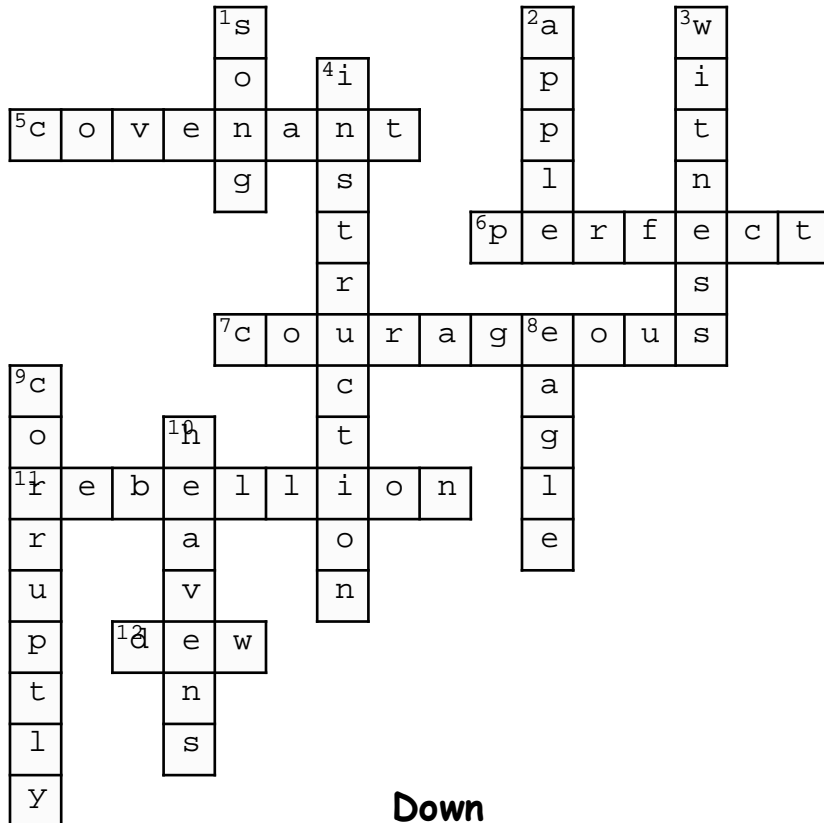

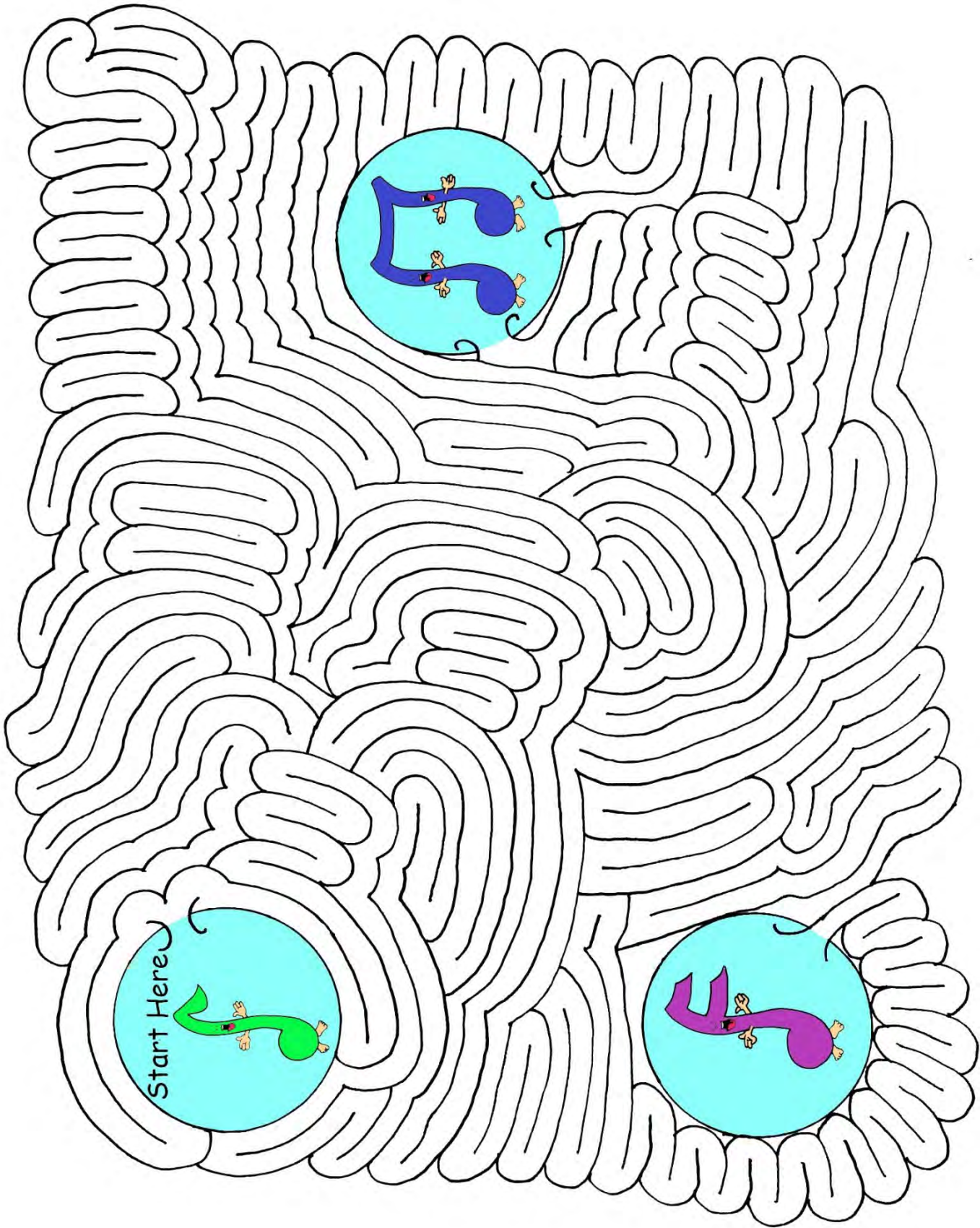

Materials:

- Copy paper
- Card stock - light blue
- Craft foam - black
- Craft foam - white
- Small pieces of craft foam - orange or yellow
- Brown butcher paper or a brown paper bag
- Sticks from your yard
- Brads
- Hot glue
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A



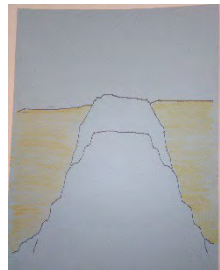
Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print the Main Page on light blue card stock as well as on copy paper (2 copies total). If blue card stock is not available, it can be printed on white card stock.
- Print Notebook Template A on copy paper.

Instructions for the Notebook page:

- If using blue card stock, color the land on both sides of the mountain. This will be used as your Main Page. (P1)
- Cut out the mountain from the copy paper. This will be used as a template. (P2)
- Trace the mountain on a piece of brown butcher paper or a paper bag. Set it aside. (P2)
- Cut the upper part of the mountain off the copy paper and trace the smaller mountain on a different piece of butcher paper or paper bag. (P3)
- Cut both pieces of the mountain from the brown paper. (P4)
- Crumble the pieces and smooth them back out. This will give the paper a rough texture look. (P4)

Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the Notebook page cont'd:

- The mountain pieces will be a little bit larger than the ones on the blue card stock. Take the hot glue and begin putting a little bit of hot glue starting at the top of the mountain and going down one side. Start pressing the larger mountain piece on the glue and continue doing this until the large mountain piece is glued to the page. (P5)
- The second piece will be glued to the larger mountain. Just begin putting glue on the mountain and gluing the smaller mountain piece in the same manner you did the larger mountain except on top of the large mountain. (P6)
- Both mountain pieces should bubble out some to give it a 3D effect. (P6)
- Take sticks and begin building a nest on top of the smaller mountain. (P6) There is no set way on how to do this, just begin gluing one stick at a time as they fit until you have the desired look. Set the page aside.
- Cut out all the pieces on Notebook Template A, do NOT color them, P8 they will be used to trace on the craft foam. (P7)
- Trace the 4 wing pieces, and the body (the oval) on black craft foam. Cut out all the pieces. Set them aside. (P8)
- Trace the head and tail pieces on white craft foam. Cut them out and set them aside. (P9)
- Cut 2 small baby bird shapes out of the scraps from the black craft foam. (P10)
- Cut a beak for the eagle and small little triangles for the beaks for the baby birds from the orange craft foam. (P11)

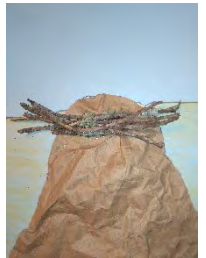
Assemble the Eagle

- Take left wing 1 and place the inside wing section behind the eagle's body, so that the tip comes to just the bottom of the eagle's body. Push a brad on the upper part of the body through the wing. Open legs to fasten.
- Take left wing 2 and align it with the outside of wing 1 section. Place a brad at the top of the wing where both pieces meet.
- Repeat for the other wing.
- The wings should be able to move and spread apart. Be careful not to pull hard. (P12)

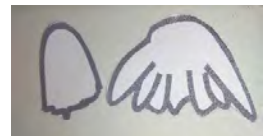

Notebook Page - page 3:

Instructions for the Notebook page cont'd:

- Glue the head to the top front of the body. (P13)
- Glue the tail to the bottom back of the body. (P13)
- Glue the beak in place. (P14)
- Draw some eyes on the eagle's face, and some feathers on the head and tail. (P14)
- Set eagle aside.
- Glue the orange triangles which represent the beak to top of the baby birds you made. (P14, 15)
- Glue the baby birds in the nest. (P15)
- Turn your page face down; place the eagle on the top edge of the paper so the brads can be seen on the top. Make a mark to see how far the brads are from each other. (P16)
- Cut 2 slits right on the marks from above. Should be about $\frac{1}{2}$ " apart and about 2" down. Make sure you do NOT make the slits too far down. (P17)
- Slide the brads on the eagle's torso onto the slits. This part may need to be completed by an adult. But also make sure the eagle can move up and down on the slits. (P18)

Edible Eagles Deuteronomy 32:10-11



Servings: 6

Ingredients:

- 1/4 c. white chocolate chips
- 6 lg. kosher marshmallows
- Finely shredded coconut
- 6 chocolate covered sandwich cookies
- 6 whole cashews
- Candy eyes

Instructions:

Melt chocolate chips according to the package directions. For each bird, drop a large marshmallow into the melted chocolate, using a spatula, coat it well. Remove the marshmallow from the chocolate and roll it in the coconut, leaving one end uncovered. Immediately set the marshmallow, coconut free end down, atop chocolate cookie. Let the chocolate set a bit, then use a toothpick to make a hole in the side of the marshmallow and insert a cashew for the beak. Finally, add the candy eyes.
