

Precious Possessions

CRAFT

Materials:

- $\frac{1}{2}$ " PVC tubing - 22" long (1)
- Burlap, ribbon or masking tape - 4" (2)
- Yarn - measured 18" and pulled tight (3)
- Rounded bamboo skewers - 12" (3)
- Large pompom or cotton ball (1)
- Felt - 6" x 3" (1)
- Elastic band (1)
- Glue or tape
- Acrylic paint - brown and/or black
- Small foam paint brush

Genesis 21:20



Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Cut a 1" slit at each end of the PVC pipe; ensure that these cuts are on the same side as this will hold your string.
- Consider painting the ends of the PVC pipe only.

Instructions for the Craft:

Bow

- Knot the 3 strands of yarn together and braid the strands to create a thicker string -knot the other end to secure. (P1)
- Insert knotted end into the slit at one end of the PVC pipe, then while bending the PVC pipe insert the other knotted end into the other slit. (P2)
- Paint the PVC pipe in whatever color you like. We used a combination of brown and black. (P3)
- Once dry, wrap burlap, ribbon or masking tape around each end to secure the string. Secure with a string if necessary. (P4)

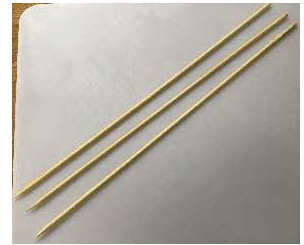

Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

Arrow

- Tape 3 rounded bamboo skewers together at both ends. (P5, P6)
- Put a large dab of glue into the center of a large pompom or cotton ball. (P7)
- Insert the pointed end of the skewers into the pompom/cotton ball and hold to secure - make sure not to push through. (P8)
- Use tape to secure the pompom to the skewers. (P8)
- Taking the 6" x 3" piece of felt, cut off corners to create more of an oval shape. (P9)
- Place the pompom end into the center of the piece of felt and wrap - securing with an elastic band. (P10)
