

# CRAFT 2

## Manna and Quail Scene

Exodus 16:1-22 and Numbers 11:1-9, 31-32

### Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Rice
- Cotton balls
- Ruler (to assist in folding)
- Double-sided adhesive foam dimensionals
- Double-sided adhesive tape
- Clear glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencil, crayons or markers
- Craft Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)



### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Craft Templates of choice on white cardstock.

### Instructions for the Craft:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)
- Adhere double-sided adhesive foam dimensionals onto the back of all the Template pieces. (P2)
- Place the single quail on the left side of the Main page near the basket over it's drawing. (P3)
- Place the multiple quail on the left side of the Main Page near the man with the basket in his arms. (P4)
- Place the basket on the right side of the Main Page in between the adults and children. (P5)
- You are now ready to make the 3-D basket. (P6)
- Using a ruler to assist you, fold the Main Page on the dotted lines. (P7)





## Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

### *Making and Placing the 3-D Basket*

- Using a ruler to assist you, fold the tabs on the basket. (P8a, P8b)
- Roll double-sided adhesive tape onto the tabs and connect the basket to the white indicators on the Main Page. (P9)

### *Embellishing the Main Page*

- Place glue onto the dimensionalized basket and sprinkle some rice onto the glue. (P10a, P10b)
- Place glue on the folded edge on the right side of the Main Page and sprinkle some rice onto the glue. (P11a, P11b)
- Place glue under the 3-D basket. (P12)
- Stuff the basket with cotton balls and place glue on the top of the pile. (P13)
- Sprinkle some rice onto the glue. (P14)

*You now have a visual representation of the manna and quail that Yahweh provided to the children of Yisra'el to feed them in the wilderness.*


