Manna Bowls

Exodus 16:16-21

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Pompoms - white (various sizes)
- Pipe cleaner - brown
- Metal paint - color of choice
- Q-tip (to assist in spreading paint)
- Tweezers (to assist in placement)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Craft Templates: Main Page (BW) or Main Page (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Main Page of choice on white cardstock.



Instructions for the Craft:

- If using BW Main Page, color using medium of choice.
- Apply glue to the manna bowl on the left. (P1)
- Add white pompoms to the bowl as desired. (P2)
- Apply glue to the manna bowl with the worms on the right. (P3)
- First, add white pompoms to the bowl as desired. (P4)
- Then, cut part of a brown pipe cleaner into various sizes ranging from $\frac{1}{4}$ " to $\frac{3}{4}$ " to create the worms. We cut 6. (P5)





Instructions for the Craft cont'd:

- Apply glue to the pipe cleaner and place in between the white pompoms. (P6a, P6b)
- Allow to dry. (P7)
- If desired, embellish the bowls using metallic paint color of choice. (P8a, P8b)

You now have a visual representation of the manna that Yahweh had provided the children of Yisra'el while they were in the wilderness for 40 years, including what happened to their portion if they left any until morning.
