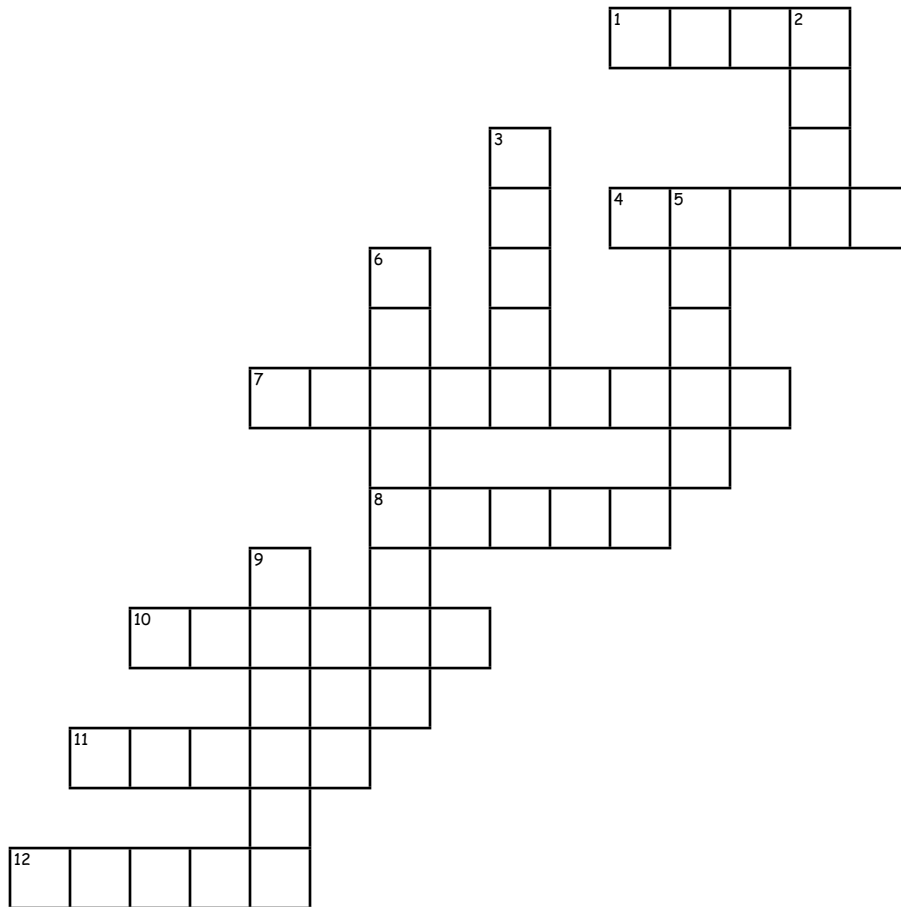


CROSSWORD PUZZLE

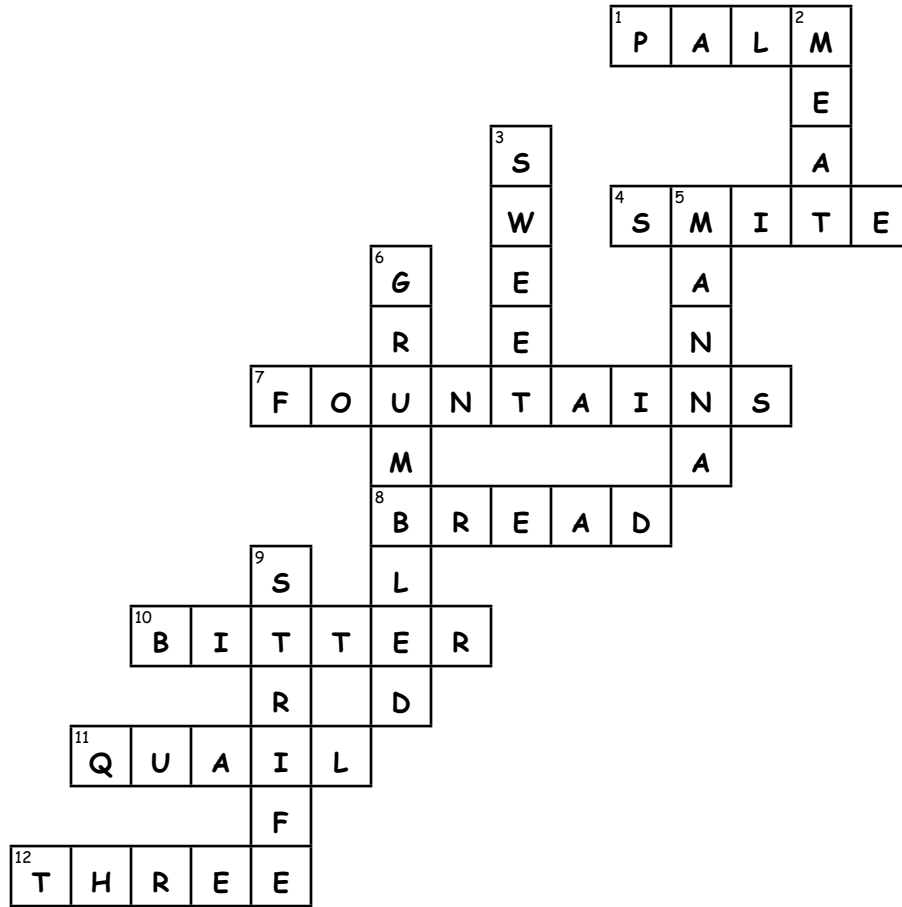
