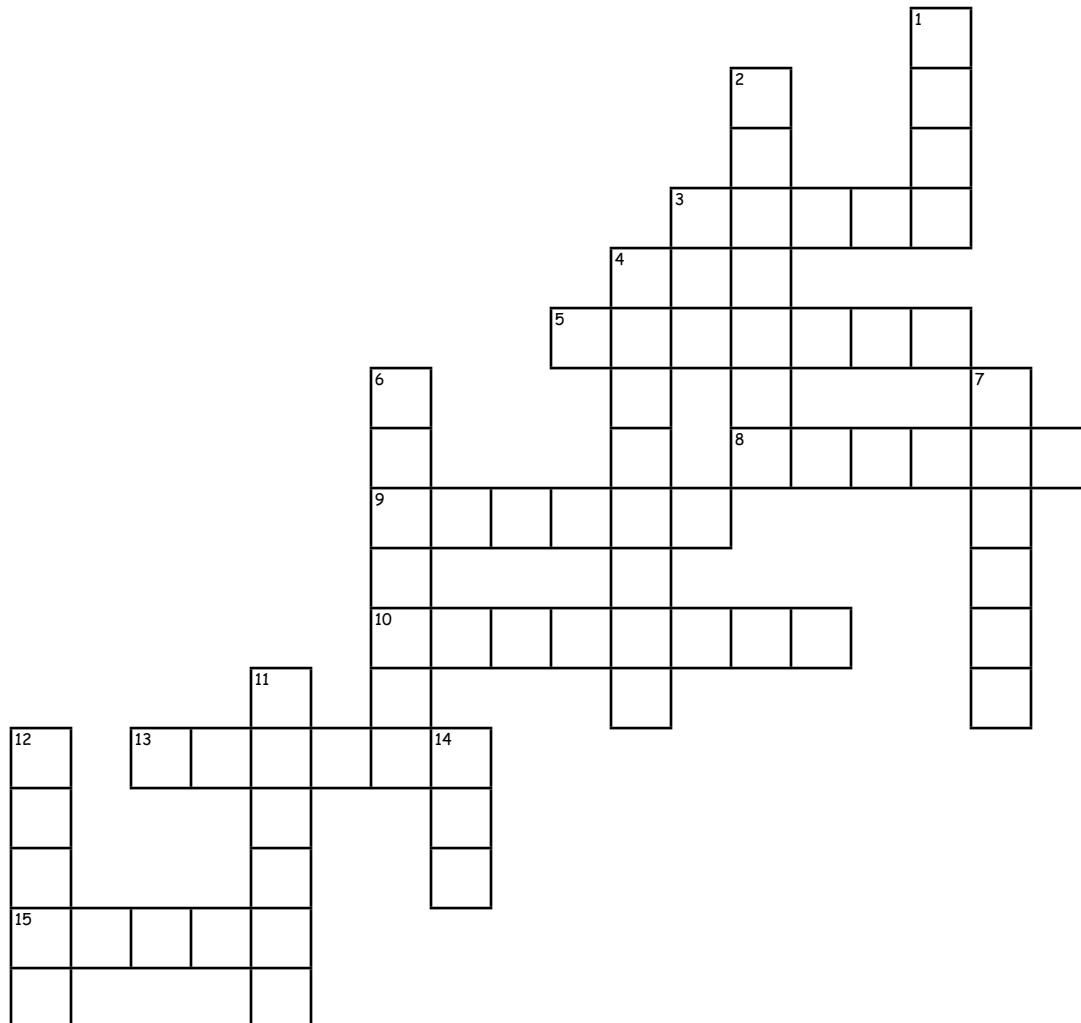


# CROSSWORD PUZZLE

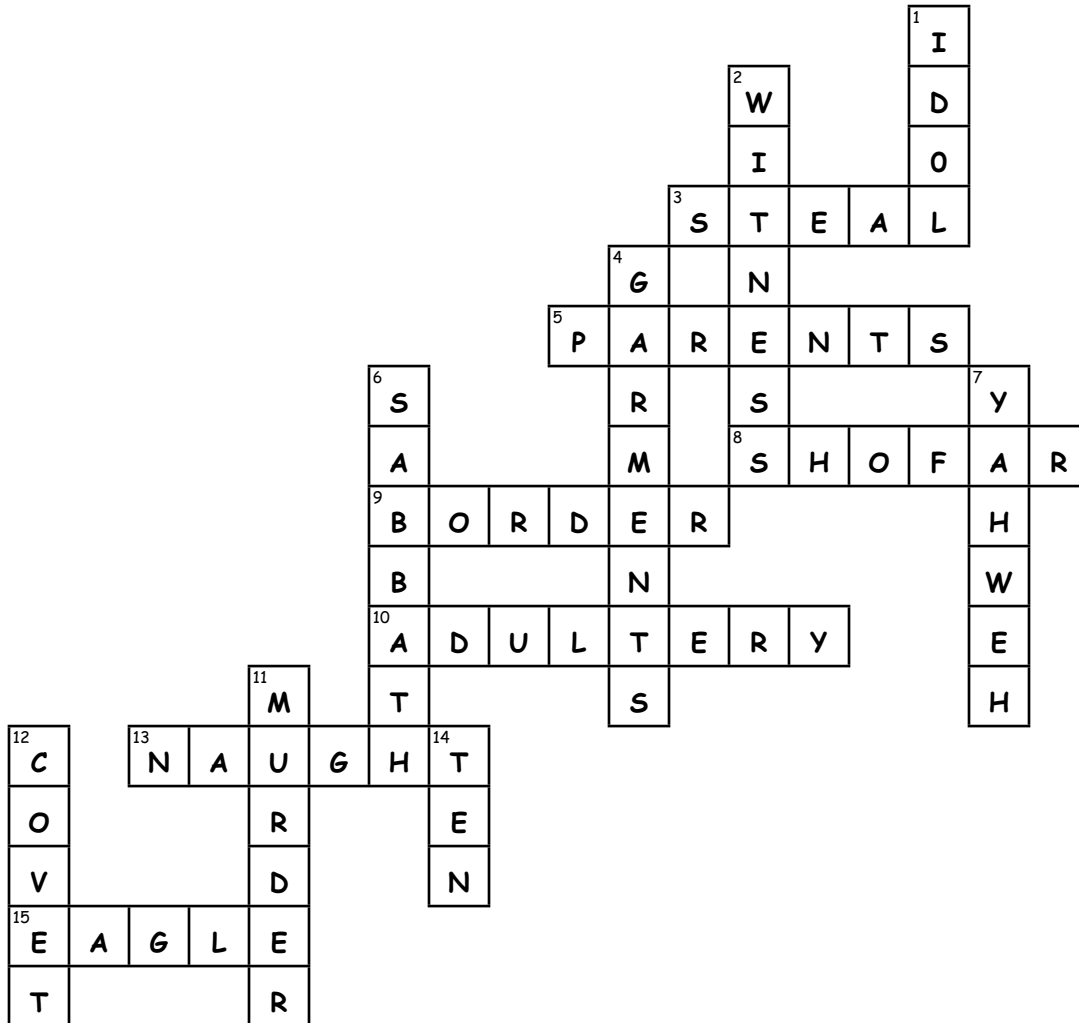
