# Precious Possessions

## **NOTEBOOK PAGE**

### **Materials**:

- Cardstock white
- Tissue or construction paper green, red, orange & yellow
- String white & blue
- Glitter glue gold, silver, purple
- Puffy paint red
- Double-sided foam dimensional
- Permanent marker
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Pages & A (BW) or
  - Main Pages & B (color)

#### Parent/Teacher Preparation:

• Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.

There will be 2 Main Pages covering this lesson. The first will cover Commandments 1-5. The second page will cover Commandments 6-10.

### Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all pieces from Notebook Template A or B. (P1)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Commandment - Aleph (N) (Main Page 1)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Aleph (N) brown on Main Page 1.
- Write: (P2)
  - > 1) "Ehyeh" on the upper part of the Aleph (x)
  - > 2) "אחיה" in the center of the Aleph (א)
  - > 3) "I AM" on the lower part of the Aleph (x).
- This depiction refers back to parsha Shemot (Ex. 3:14) where Yahweh reveals His Name and corresponds to this commandment.













#### The 10 Commandments Exodus 20:1-17



### 1<sup>st</sup> Commandment - Aleph (N) (Main Page 1) cont'd

- Rip small pieces of green tissue paper or construction paper and scrunch them to make little balls of leaves. (P3)
- Cut small flames out of red, yellow and orange tissue paper or construction paper. (P3)
- Glue the green leaves around the Aleph (N).
  (P4)
- Glue the flames around the green leaves. (P5)
- The 1<sup>st</sup> commandment is now finished. (P6)

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Commandment - Bet (3) (Main Page 1)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Bet (3) section on Main Page 1.
- Adhere a foam dimensional to the back of the 10 Commandments tablets and place in the center of the Bet. (P7)
- Add dimension to the moon and stars by using silver puffy paint.
  (P8)
- Add dimension to the sun and rays by using gold glitter glue. (P9)
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> commandment is now finished. (P9)














### $3^{rd}$ Commandment - Gimel (1) (Main Page 1)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Gimel (1) on Main Page 1 and on the Gimel Template cut-out.
- Using a puncturing tool, poke a hole through the 2 small circles at the bottom of the Gimel (1). (P10)
- Cut 4 pieces of white string and 2 pieces of blue string about 12" long. (P11)
- Thread one end of the white string through the hole halfway so that you have equal lengths on both sides of the hole. (P12)
- You need to do this 4 times. Each hole will have 2 white strings, but it will make 4 strings per hole. (P13a)
- Now, thread one end of the blue string through the hole halfway so that you have equal lengths on both sides of the hole.
- You need to do 1 blue string per hole. (P13b)
- Don't worry about the string being different lengths. You will cut them later.
- Take a small piece of blue string and tie it around the white strings a few times. (P14)
- Tie 4 knots around each pair of white strings. (P15)
- Using scissors, trim the white strings to desired length. (P16)
- Using scissors, trim the blue strings to be longer than the white strings. (P17)
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> commandment is now finished. (P18)









#### $4^{th}$ Commandment - Dalet (T) (Main Page 1)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Dalet (T) brown to represent a wood table.
- Place foam dimensional on the back of the Shabbat table and adhere to the table leg. (P19)
- The 4<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Commandment - Hey (ה) (Main Page 1)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Hey (n) using medium of choice. Adhere a foam dimensional to the back of the growing boy or girl and place in the Hey (n) section under the aging parents to depice that this command to respect our parents is intended to be a lifelong command. (P2Oa, P2Ob)
- The 5<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

#### 6<sup>th</sup> Commandment - Vav (1) (Main Page 2)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Vav (1) and heart on Main Page 2.
- Using red puffy paint, add dimension to the broken heart. (P21a)
- Using gold glitter glue, color the Vav (1) on the Main Page. (P21b)
- Place foam dimensional on the back of the crying boy.
- Adhere the boy under the scolding adult. (P21c, P21d)
- The 6<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

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### 7<sup>th</sup> Commandment - Zayin (1) (Main Page 2)

- If using BW Main Page color the Zayin (1) on the Main Page.
- Using red puffy paint, add dimension to the flowers. (P22a)
- Adhere a foam dimensional to the back of the bride and groom.
- Place couple under the chuppah. (P22b)
- The 7<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

### 8<sup>th</sup> Commandment - Chet (n) (Main Page 2)

- If using BW Template, color the Chet (n) and the children on the swings using medium of choice.
- Place foam dimensional on the back of the backpack and person crouched over trying to be sneaky. (P23a)
- Place backpack and person stealing in the Chet (n) section. (P23b)
- The 8<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

### 9<sup>th</sup> Commandment - Tet (0) (Main Page 2)

- If using BW Main Page, color the Tet (**v**) and whispering girls using medium of choice. (P24)
- Adhere a foam dimensional to the back of the single girl and place in the Tet (0) section.
- This section represents someone talking 'lashon hara' about another and misrepresenting the person.
- The 9<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

### 10<sup>th</sup> Commandment - Yod (<sup>1</sup>) (Main Page 2)

- Place foam dimensional on the back of the balloon. (P25a)
- Adhere over the Yod (') on the Main Page.
- Using purple glitter glue, add dimension to the balloon (P25b, P25c)
- In our example, we used the Yod (\*) to represent the phrase 'green with envy'.
- The 10<sup>th</sup> commandment is now finished.

- Write the following directly on the Main Page or a piece of colored cardstock and glue to the page:
  - > 1) Mitzvot 2) מצות (3) Commands
