TREASURING HIS WORD

Let's do a quick overview of the entire Torah portion:

Monday:	Num. 13:1-25	One man from each of the twelve tribes sent to spy out the land of Kena'an
Tuesday:	Num. 13:26-33	The spies return with a report
Wednesday:	Num. 14	The children of Yisra'el rebel; Mosheh intercedes for the people; Yahweh relents, pronounces judgments
Thursday:	Num. 15:1-31	Instructions for various offerings and unintentional sins
Friday:	Num. 15:32-41	Penalty for violating Shabbat; Torah regarding tzitziyot

In this week's Parsha Pearls lesson, Yahweh gives Mosheh details regarding different offerings that He wants the children of Yisra'el to bring to Him when they enter the land. We will review the offerings that we learned about in parashot Vayikra and Tzav, as well as give more details about these offerings. Now, let's read Num. 15:1-31.

PARSHA POINTS

- Yahweh told Mosheh to speak to the children of Yisra'el regarding the offerings they were to perform when they entered Kena'an - 15:1-2

Instructions for Various Offerings

- Yahweh gave Mosheh instructions regarding offerings made by fire for the following (15:3-13):
 - in fulfilling a vow
 - in bringing one (**achat**) of the 3 (**shalosh**) voluntary offerings (burnt, grain, peace) in observing His Appointed Times

- The natives (**eizrach**) were instructed to bring the following animals to be offered as sweet fragrances to Yahweh (15:13):

- lamb
- ram
- young bull
- young goat



- With each lamb they were to include (15:4-5):
 - a grain offering (1/10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with 1/4th of a hin of oil)
 - a drink offering (1/4th of a hin of wine)



- With each ram they were to include (15:6-7):
 - a grain offering (2/10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with 1/3rd of a hin of oil)
 - a drink offering (1/3rd of a hin of wine)



- With each young bull or goat, they were to include (15:8-10):
 - a grain offering (3/10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with 1/2 a hin of oil)
 - a drink offering (1/2 a hin of wine)



- When the stranger (**ger**) who sojourned among the natives made an offering made by fire as a sweet fragrance to Yahweh, the following instructions would apply (15:14-16):
 - One law would apply to both the native and to the stranger
 - It was to be a law forever throughout their generations
 - As the native would be, so a stranger would be before Yahweh
 - One Torah and one right-ruling would apply to both the native and for the stranger



First-fruits Contribution

- Yahweh instructed Mosheh to tell the children of Yisra'el that they should bring to Him a contribution of a cake (**challah**) made of the first of their dough from their threshing floor - 15:17-21
- This was to be a contribution (**terumah**) throughout their generations - 15:21



Sin Offering (congregation)

- When the congregation sinned by mistake and failed to do all the commands which Yahweh had instructed, then the children of Yisra'el must offer the following (15:24):
 - a young bull as a burnt offering as a sweet fragrance to Yahweh
 - + grain offering
 - + drink offering
 - + male goat as a sin offering
- Then the priest was to make atonement for all the congregation; because the trespass was done by mistake, it would be forgiven them - 15:25-26



Sin Offering (individual)

- When a person sinned by mistake and failed to do all the commands which Yahweh had instructed, the individual must offer (15:27):
 - a female goat a year old
- Then, because the trespass was done by mistake, the priest was to make atonement for the individual, and it would be forgiven him - 15:28
- For the one who sinned by mistake, there would be one Torah for both the native and the stranger - 15:29
- The being who sinned defiantly, whether he was a native or a stranger, was guilty of reviling Yahweh. For despising the word of Yahweh and breaking His command, that one must be cut off from all his people - 15:30-31



DIGGING DEEPER

Parents/Teachers may choose to use these prompts for further discussion of the Torah portion.

- Notice that the instructions about offerings in Chapter 15 follow on the heels of the incident with the spies. Although Yahweh must punish them for doubting and slandering Him, could this be His way of reassuring them that the day will come when He would bring His people into the land of Promise?
- Notice in v. 30-31 that Yahweh mentions no offering that can be brought for one who acts defiantly. Discuss whether that would work in today's society. If so, how?

NOTEBOOK PAGE

Materials:

- Cardstock - white
- Tweezers - to assist in placement
- Pipe cleaners - light and dark brown (8-10 pieces, cut $\frac{1}{4}$ ")
- Sequins of choice - large purple (for figs), small green (for grapes and olives)
- Beads of choice - red (for pomegranates), light beige (for wheat), olive green (for barley)
- Double-sided foam dimensional
- Tacky glue
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Notebook Templates: Main Page & A (BW) or Main Page & B (color)

Parent/Teacher Preparation:

- Print Notebook Templates of choice on white cardstock.

Instructions for the Notebook Page:

- If using BW Templates, color using medium of choice.
- Cut out all Template pieces. (P1)

Embellishing the Baskets

- Adhere a foam dimensional to the front of the basket of wheat and place wheat tops onto the dimensional. (P2a, P2b)
- Cut brown pipe cleaners into $\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces, cutting enough to cover basket.
- Spread Tacky glue onto the dates and lay the pipe cleaners on top of the glue. (P3a, P3b)
- Spread Tacky glue onto the figs and lay purple sequins on top of the glue. We left the figs on the left side not covered. (P4a, P4b)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the grapes and lay the sequins on top of the glue. We left the sides not covered. (P5a, P5b)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the olives and lay the sequins on top of the glue. We left the sides not covered. (P6a, P6b)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the pomegranates and lay the beads on top of the glue. We left the sides not covered. (P7a, P7b)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the wheat kernels and lay the beads on top of the glue. We put on a few. (P8a, P8b)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the barley kernels and lay the beads on top of the glue. We put on a few. (P9a, P9b)
- Lay baskets aside to dry. (P10)

Placing the Baskets on the Main Page

- Before adding baskets permanently to the Main Page, stage them so that you have enough room for your Hebrew words. (P11)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the back of the basket of wheat stalks and place on Main Page underneath the native Yisra'elites and sojourners. (P12a, P12b)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Adhere 2 round foam dimensionals to the back of the wheat kernels basket and place on Main Page over the wheat stalks basket. (P13a, P13b)
- Flip the barley kernels sacks over and place a round foam dimensional on the lower left corner. (P14)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the front right side of the wheat kernels sack and place the barley kernels sack over it. (P15a, P15b)
- You now have the wheat basket and the raised wheat and barley kernels sacks on the Main Page. (P16)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the back of the pomegranates basket and place on Main Page next to the wheat stalks. (P17a, P17b)
- Spread *Tacky* glue onto the back of the olives basket and place on Main Page underneath and to the left of the pomegranate basket. (P18a, P18b)
- Adhere 2 round foam dimensionals to the back of the dates basket and place on the bottom and right side of the olives basket. (P19a, P19b)
- Adhere 2 round foam dimensionals to the back of the grapes basket and place on the right side of the pomegranates basket. (P20a, P20b)

Instructions for the Notebook Page Cont'd:

- Adhere 2 round foam dimensionals to the back of the figs basket and place over the bottom of the grapes basket. (P21a, P21b)
- Allow the 6 baskets and 2 sacks to dry. (P22)

SWEET TASTE OF TORAH

This snack relates to this week's parsha. Please take these as suggestions and make necessary changes based on your individual dietary needs.

Challah

Numbers 15:20



Ingredients:

- 1 egg
- 3 Tbsp. butter
- 3/4 c. milk
- 2 Tbsp. honey
- 1 tsp. salt
- 3 c. bread flour
- 1 Tbsp. dry active yeast

Instructions:

Combine the ingredients in a bread machine pan or bowl in the order listed above. For the bread machine, set the machine to the dough cycle.

For the bowl, knead for 15 minutes then cover. Wait 45 minutes, then knead again for several minutes. Cover again and wait until the bread rises; about 30 minutes.


When the dough is ready, cut into 2 halves and roll them into long pieces. Place them on a cookie sheet. Attach the halves by the end and wrap them. Cover and let rise.

Bake at 350° for 20 minutes.

*You can use the Katan A challah cover craft to place over your bread.
